

A MESSAGE FROM FR. MARC



Fr. Marc Bishop - Pastor St. Agnes and St. Camillus

Dear Parish Family, Last weekend we announced that Fr. Michael Zimmerman has been assigned to the Vocation Office of the Archdiocese of Boston. When his replacement is assigned Fr. Michael will be sent from us to share his considerable talents with the entire Archdiocese. I truly mean "sent from us." The gifts and talents Fr. Michael learned and refined while serving our community will serve him well as he seeks to mentor men as they discern and discover their

vocation. We can support him with prayer and fostering attitudes and programs that support vocational discernment. I have recognized this transition as a moment to recommit ourselves to support and foster the vocation to the priesthood, consecrated life, marriage and the permanent diaconate. We can start with prayer and form attitudes and programs to support the vocational discernment of the members of our faith family and beyond.

Please, offer prayers for the priest who will be joining our faith family. Whoever he is will need our support and kindness, as he transitions. The community he is leaving will also need our support by empathetic prayer.

The Convocation is fast approaching. As of this writing, 95 members of our faith family have registered to attend. They will be engaging in a day shaped around discussion that will form the principles of our Plan for Evangelization, a Pastoral Plan. These discussions will be informed by substantive talks and personal witlessness. I will be speaking on the state of the Church in Arlington. The Catholic Parishes of Arlington have experienced a 20% decline over the last 5 years of which we have data (2013-2018). What can we do locally to reverse this trend? What are we currently doing or not doing that may allow this trend? Together we have the ability to better communicate the great blessings that St. Camillus and St. Agnes are to our community. All voices are needed. If you have not already registered, please do so. I thank those 95 who have already made their commitment known to be a vocal servant of the Faith Family. If you are unable to attend, I ask you to pray the Prayer of St. Michael each day leading up to and including the day of the Convocation.

Last week, we sent a mailing to all registered households of St. Agnes and St. Camillus Parishes. This was a costly and needed task. The mailing contained an invitation to the Convocation and some important information about the Catholic Parishes of Arlington. This mailing was important for many reasons. The most mundane one may be the most important. It will allow us to update our databases that are in great need for better accuracy. The letter may have been sent to members of our community that are deceased or moved away. I apologize if you received a mailing with a deceased loved ones name. Please, help us correct these mistakes. It is our intent to insure that our databases are as complete and accurate as possible so that it can be a better tool to serve our parishioners. If you did not receive a letter, you are not registered at St. Camillus or St. Agnes. There are parish census (registration) forms at the doors of the Churches. Please, fill one out and return to the Collaborative Office. Thank you. I trust the good God blesses you and yours throughout the coming week.


BOSTON SOCK EXCHANGE

At the age of 14, Therese had a conversion that transformed her life. From then on, she turned toward love, instead of keeping herself happy. At 15, she entered the Carmelite convent in Lisieux to give her whole life to God. She took the religious name Sister Therese of the Child Jesus. She lived a hidden, simple life of prayer. She was gifted with intimacy with God. Through sickness, she remained faithful to God. After a long struggle with

tuberculosis, she died on September 30, 1897, at the age of 24. Her last words were the story of her life: "My God, I love You!"

We come to know Therese through her autobiography, "Story of a Soul". She described her life as a "Little way." She lived each day with confidence in God's love. She wrote, "What matters in life is not great deeds, but great love." Therese lived and taught a spirituality of attending to everyone and everything with love. She teaches us through her life to have a childlike focus and attentive love. Therese's spirituality is "doing the ordinary with extraordinary love".

She loved flowers and saw herself as the "Little flower of Jesus." She gave glory to God by just being herself among all the other flowers in God's garden. Because of this reason, the title "Little flower" remained with St. Therese. Her inspiration and powerful presence touched many people very quickly. She was canonized by Pope Pius XI on May 17, 1925. Had she lived, she would have been only 52 years old when she was declared a Saint.



St. Therese said, "My mission (to make God loved) will begin after my death. I will spend my heaven doing good on earth. I will let fall a shower of roses." Roses have been described and experienced as Saint Therese's signature. Many have been touched by her intercession and imitate her "Little way." She has been acclaimed "the greatest saint of modern times." In 1997, Pope John Paul II declared St. Therese a Doctor of the Church in tribute to the powerful way her spirituality has influenced people all over the world. The message of St. Therese is beautiful, inspiring and simple.


