The world and our lives are made up of a continuous flow of rhythms. Birth and death, the stages of life infancy through maturity to old age, the seasons of the year, natures changes throughout those seasons, even the simplicity of the rising and

setting of the sun, or the rhythm of the tides and the cycles of the moon. Our worship life in the church is also guided by a continuous flow of seasons of a three-year cycle in the Catholic Church. Our current liturgical year, year C, or the third year in the cycle is quickly coming to a close. This week is the 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time followed by Christ the King Sunday next week on November 20, which is the final Sunday of this liturgical year. I am sure that you are all quite aware that it is also the Sunday before Thanksgiving. Even our secular celebrations are seeming to fly by. Halloween is past, Veterans Day is over and very shortly we will be gathering with our families around a table for a Thanksgiving Day dinner. That particular holiday weekend will also announce the Advent season and the beginning of a new liturgical church year.

As a church musician, my life is always marked by the different celebrations and liturgies that we encounter throughout the year. Whether it is advance planning, rehearsing a choir or soloist, practicing my own craft of playing the organ or singing, or simply taking part in the moment of worship, my focus is on the beauty of the liturgy as well as the larger view of the entire journey throughout the cycles.
