#### **DID YOU KNOW?**

Holly and ivy, widely known from the popular carol, are powerful symbols for Christians.

The thorns of holly boughs point to the crown of thorns that adorned Christ's head during His passion and death.

The evergreen ivy is a metaphor for eternal life with God in heaven.



At Mass, you may have noticed one striking difference in the liturgy. During Advent, the Church refrains from singing the Gloria until Christmas Eve when we recite the words the angels exclaimed to the shepherds that very first Christmas: "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace."

#### THE ADVENT GIVING MANGER

Advent is a time of preparation as we await the coming of our Lord. We prepare our hearts with prayer, reconciliation, and reflection on how our lives bring us toward the Lord. We expand our ability to love by seeing the people around us and responding to them in caring ways.

We give through our Giving Tree, we give through our collections, we give at year end when we have enough and can share. We know that we are called to remain generous and giving of ourselves throughout the year. Our hearts remain in the Lord when filled with love, for Him, for our families, and for others.

Generosity is a habit that can be nurtured in the time of Advent. Our hearts seem more open as we contemplate that new Baby Jesus. As our Hearts open, we see those who need us. We try to find ways to help.

#### THE GIVING MANGER INSTRUCTIONS

The Giving Manger helps us shift the focus of Christmas back to giving. A piece of straw "paper" found on the cover of this bulletin, is placed in the manger for each kind deed or act of service performed. On Christmas Day, the Baby is placed in the manger filled with service and love.

# Heresy, Santa, and a Slap Across the Face.

When I speak to my baptism faith formation class, I affirm with those who are to become godparents, how important that role is and that it dates back to the beginnings of

the Church. Each godparent then, as now, was charged to protect their godchild from incorrect teaching; from those that would pull a young Christian away from the central tenets of the church. Heresy is, as the formal definition notes, a denial of a core doctrine. One such heresy that assailed the early Church was Arianism, named after a fourth century Alexandrian priest, called Arius. Arianism was the denial that the second person of the Holy Trinity was one with the Father, of the same nature, and was always with Him. Arianism taught that Jesus, as the Son of God, was created by God and did not share the same nature. This was such a contentious and serious matter that the Council of Nicea would meet to debate this notion. If in one corner was Arius, in the other was Bishop Saint Athanasius who would maintain that Jesus was of one substance with the Father (which for the sake of clarity we know to be true). As they say, feelings ran high. Well, it so happened that there was a bishop at this same meeting, with a large belly, white hair, a long beard, and red pants, jacket, and a hat, all trimmed with white\*. Yes, Santa Claus was present, our dear Saint Nicholas. Not one to withhold his feelings as Arius spoke his false ideas, Saint Nicholas got up from his chair, crossed the room and slapped Arius across the face. Unfortunately, this landed Saint Nic., in chains, in jail, and stripped of his bishop's garments. Regretful and praying for forgiveness for his action, Saint Nicholas would be found the next morning by the jailer clothed again in his bishop's garments, free of chains, and reading. That night Mary had appeared and asked him why he was in jail. 'Because I love you', he would respond, and it was she that restored his garments and her son that would provide him with a Book of the Gospels to read.

We know little of the real life of Saint Nicolas, but

there are many wonderful stories of this saint. At a young age he lost his parents. The small fortune they had left him with he decided to use for good works. In his town a poor neighbor had no dowry for his three daughters to marry. Each night for three nights Saint Nicholas would throw a bag of gold coins in through an open window so allowing his neighbor to find husbands for his daughters. You can read other stories about Saint Nicholas in the "Lives of the Saints".

Courage in the face of falsehood, faithfulness in the face of difficulties, generosity in the face of need. As we continue our Advent journey preparing for the arrival of our Lord, we can all consider where we too need to be courageous, faithful despite difficulties, and generous with what our Lord places in our hands. Dear Saint Nicholas pray for us, for our parish members and for all those newly baptized, for their parents and godparents.

### Nativity Crèche

In its present form, the custom of displaying figures depicting the birth of Christ owes its origin to St. Francis of Assisi, who made the Christmas crèche for Christmas Eve of 1223.

# Music Notes from Roger





#### **SVDP SNAPSHOT FISCAL YEAR**



October 1, 2021 - September 30, 2022 The Arlington SVdP files an annual report each November for the previous fiscal year. We wanted to share with you the highlights to let you know how your donations are

helping those in need in Arlington.

- Fiscal Year Income: \$26,354 and Fiscal Year Expenditures: \$27,388 for a net loss of \$1,034
- Income sources: \$24,439.00 in gifts/donations and \$1,915.00 in Arlington EATS grants
- SVdP Home Visits: 92 people served and \$11,000 spent on rent, utilities, food and more
- SVdP Holiday Meals (three times a year we provide a full holiday meal to those in need): 495 people served meals worth \$5,200
- SVdP Camperships and Scholarships for those in need attending Fidelity House or AC/St Agnes): 8 children served and \$6,000 spent
- Monthly assistance to our sister St. Mary of the Assumption SVdP Conference which serves a very needy community in Lawrence: \$4,400 spent

In addition to these activities, SVdP also provides weekly rosary/communion services at Sunrise Senior Living, supports the Boston Sock Exchange, conducts clothing drives, and facilitates food donations to Arlington EATS. 


