

Welcome to Holy Week. We begin this week by reading the Passion Narrative according to Matthew. We will again participate in the Passion of Christ on Good Friday, as we read John's account. Notice the word "participate." We are not merely taking part in a history lesson. We are choosing to live the events of Holy Week with Christ. We share

in the joyful expectation of Christ's triumphant entrance into Jerusalem. We are bewildered by Jesus' arrest. We are pained by the crucifixion and confused by what didn't happen. All leading to the exuberance of the resurrection. It is important for us to not merely show up. We must earnestly choose to be a part of the journey that is Holy Week.

This past week many joined in our Lenten Mission. It was a mission designed to lead us to be in-mission.

Together, we explored a dream. My dream for our faith family; which I prayerfully discerned from the prodding of the Holy Spirit over the last five years.

This event is a prayerful response to SatanCon, a gathering of satanists that weekend, in Boston. We will gather for Eucharistic Adoration and Benediction. Talks and prayers will be offered throughout the three hours. Please, sign-up to commit to a time of prayer during the event.

We will humbly go before the Lord to witness to the world who God is. Please join us.


OUR EASTER GIFT TO YOU PICK UP YOURS EASTER DAY

Easter Blessing of Food -**Blessing of Easter Baskets**

Saturday 8th April at 10:00AM following morning prayer and confession.

Saint Camillus Church front of church (in the event of inclement weather — lower church)

Background

During the Middle Ages in Europe, it was forbidden to eat certain foods during the rigorous Lenten period of fast and abstinence. At the end of Lent these foods were again allowed and with great joy and gratitude the foods were taken to church for a blessing. Today we too can have our food blessed and prepared for the Easter Sunday celebration. With hearts filled with joy because of the resurrection we can truly celebrate. This year rather than filling Easter Baskets with candy fill them with foods that nourish your family both symbolically and actually.

What to include in an Easter Basket to be blessed.

- Eggs a traditional symbol of the resurrection and new life. These can be brightly colored or decorated.
- Bread symbolizing Jesus Christ who is the 'Bread of Life'.
- Meats Lamb symbolizing Jesus the Lamb who was sacrificed for our sins. Also ham or bacon, disallowed in the Old Testament, but now allowed as Christ makes all things new.
- Sausage symbolizing the chain of slavery and death that Jesus breaks once and for all.
- Salt reminding us that we are to be salt and as a symbol of our hospitality.
- Candle an unlit candle to be lit on your Easter Sunday brunch, lunch or dinner, to remind us that it is Christ who is the light of the world.
- Wine symbolizing joy and the many graces and blessings that we have been fortunate to receive.

One or more of these items can be placed in a

wicker or wooden basket and then covered with a tea towel or cloth. This cloth symbolizes the burial cloth of Christ that wrapped his body. Additionally, flowers or evergreens can be placed on top of this cloth.

Come and join us and your parish family for this simple blessing of the food we will consume on Easter Sunday.

SCRIPTURE FOR MEDITATION

Read slowly, 3-4 times. Allow the words of Scripture to wash over your mind and heart. Let the Holy Spirit speak to you through this passage.

"Pilate said to them, 'Then what shall I do with Jesus called Christ?' The all said, 'Let him be crucified!' But he said, 'Why? What evil has he done?' They only shouted louder, 'Let him be crucified!'" (Matthew 27:22-23)

Jesus the Innocent Lamb of God, takes on the burden of our sin. Imagine how he felt as he heard the crowds shout mercilessly, "Let him be crucified!" Gazing upon Jesus in the Eucharist, allow yourself to enter into Jesus' experience of rejection and sorrow that he bore for your sin. Ask him to help you experience sorrow for your own sins and seek forgiveness, especially in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Remain in silence with the Lord. Allow him to speak in the silence, in your heart. Receive his presence. If it helps, write down what you sense the Lord is communicating to you during this time of prayer.

PRAY

Almighty, ever-living God, who as an example of humility for the human race to follow caused our Savior to take flesh and submit to the Cross, graciously grant that we may heed his lesson of patient suffering and so merit a share in his Resurrection. Who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever. (Collect, Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion).

GRAND ANNUAL PART 2

As we have reported in the bulletin, we are behind our goals for weekly collections, and unexpected expenses have stretched our resources. The replacement of the boiler at St. Agnes Church cost approximately \$70,000, and we have also made significant improvements to the Church sound system, including hearing assist devices. In addition, the Bell Tower at St. Camillus has been identified as having damaged bricks, and we are working with engineers to assess the cost of repairs, including the anticipated expense of scaffolding. We are also planning renovations to St. Camillus' lower Church Hall, including painting and new chairs and tables, estimated to cost \$35,000.


Mt 21: 1-11

When Jesus and the disciples drew near Jerusalem and came to Bethphage on the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two disciples, saying to them, "Go into the village opposite you, and immediately you will find an ass tethered, and a colt with her. Untie them and bring them here to me. And if anyone should say anything to you, reply, 'The master has need of them.' Then he will send them at once." This happened so that what had been spoken through the prophet might be fulfilled: Say to daughter Zion, "Behold, your king comes to you, meek and riding on an ass, and on a colt, the foal of a beast of burden." The disciples went and did as Jesus had ordered them. They brought the ass and the colt and laid their cloaks over them, and he sat upon them. The very large crowd spread their cloaks on the road, while others cut branches from the trees and strewed them on the road. The crowds preceding him and those following kept crying out and saying: "Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord; hosanna in the highest." And when he entered Jerusalem the whole city was shaken and asked, "Who is this?" And the crowds replied, "This is Jesus the prophet, from Nazareth in Galilee."




FIRST READING


Phil 2: 6-11
