

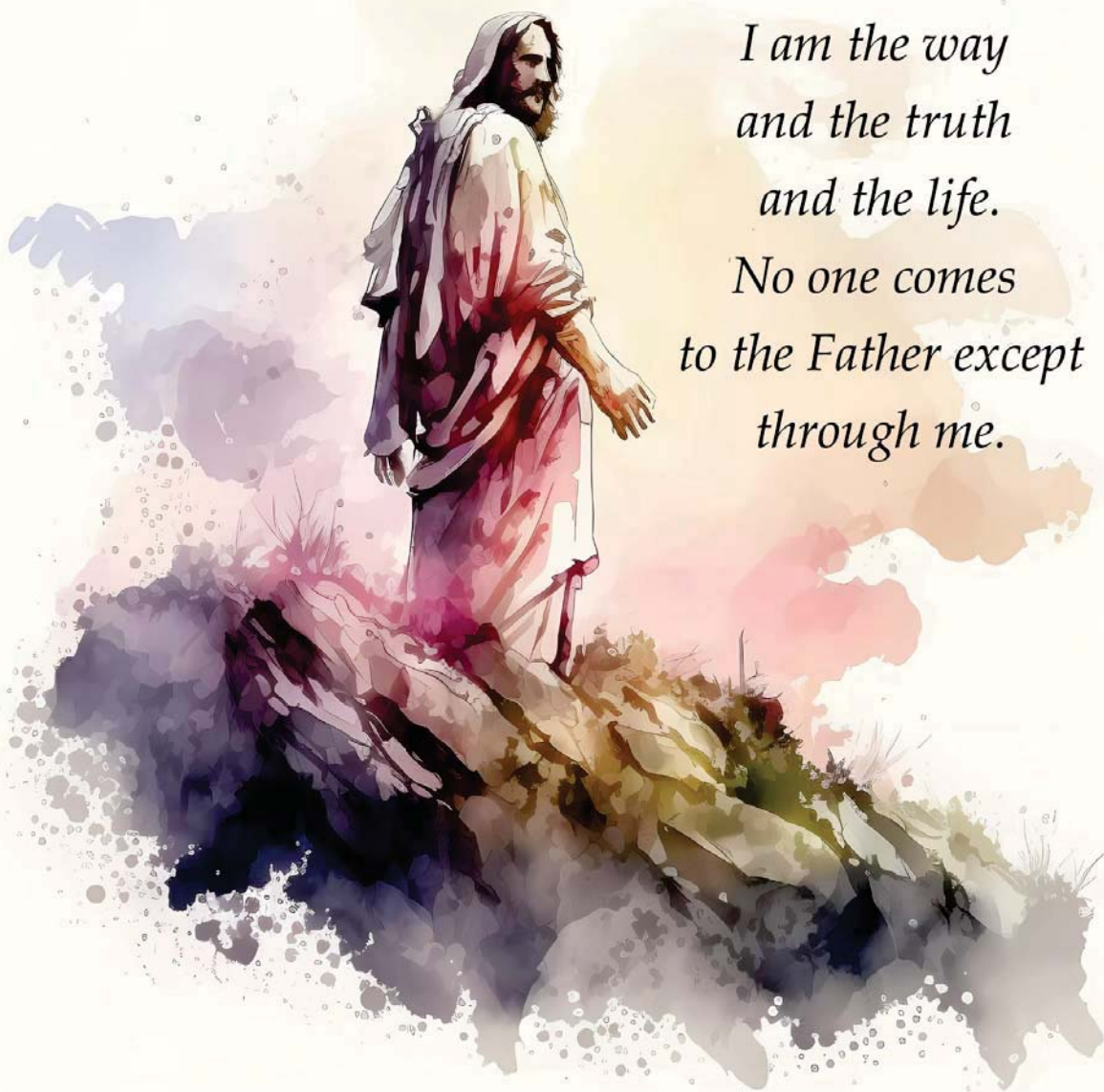

NAVIGATING MARRIED LIFE

Are you struggling in your marriage?

You are need not struggle alone.

There is always hope.

On their wedding day, the bride and groom vow to be faithful to each other “for better, for worse, for richer, for poorer, in sickness and in health, until death do us part.” Marriage is a beautiful and sacred union, where the couple witnesses Christ's spousal love for the Church. But it requires work and commitment from both partners, and sooner or later, all couples face “worse,” “poorer,” or “sickness” challenges. At times, these issues may feel insurmountable.

Retrouvaille is a Christian program, with Catholic origins, designed to develop and strengthen communication skills and heal broken marriages. The presenters are not professional marriage counselors, just couples sharing their own heartfelt stories of their marriage struggles. In short, it's couples helping couples renew their marriage, and rediscover loving relationships.

Our Lady of Fatima

20TH CENTURY
FEAST DAY: MAY 13

Mary appeared to three peasant children near Fatima, Portugal, six times between May 13 and October 13, 1917, and asked for prayers for world peace and an end to World War I, for sinners, and for the conversion of Russia. She entrusted the children with three secrets, regarding devotion to her Immaculate Heart, a vision of hell, and a “bishop in white” shot by soldiers firing bullets and arrows. Many connect the third secret to the attempted assassination of Blessed Pope John Paul II on May 13, 1981, and the pope thanked Mary for guiding the bullet and saving him. At the Vatican last October 13, Pope Francis stood before the statue of Our Lady from the Fatima shrine and formally entrusted the world to Mary.

As of May 2nd, the Grand Annual collection at St. Agnes is \$101,610, compared to the original budgeted goal of \$125,000. This does not include the unexpected cost of \$70,000 to replace the church boiler.

The Grand Annual collection of St. Camillus is \$61,987 compared to the original budgeted goal of \$45,000. This does not include unexpected repairs to the rectory roof of \$54,000 as well as renovations of the lower church.

Contributing to the Grand Annual capital campaign can be a way to give back and show appreciation for the church's role in your life. If you have not done so already, we ask each working adult to contribute \$350 to the Grand Annual Collection.

COLLABORATIVE PASTORAL COUNCIL (CPC) OF THE CATHOLIC PARISHES OF ARLINGTON **DISCERNMENT PERIOD: MAY 7- 21**

The "CPC" is comprised of 12 (6 from each parish) elected community members, the Parish Clergy, and two staff members. The CPC works with the staff to guide the work and community life of the Collaborative. In addition, one youth member (a person from 14 to 19 years of age, and in High School) will be appointed to the Council. Youth may be nominated as well. Council members will be elected to serve 2-year terms beginning in June 2023.

Elections will be held for six seats (3 from each parish) annually. Terms are renewable twice. The Pastor can appoint members ex officio as is required to best serve the community. The CPC is not a legislative body, it is an essential advisor to the Pastor.

Qualifications:

- Involvement in one or more of the Collaborative ministries or groups
- Desire to contribute to the overall health of the CPARL Faith Family
- Enjoy looking at "the big picture" Desire to help people connect more deeply with each other and the Church
- Have a real heart for implementing the community's vision in the Pastoral Plan and helping the community determine "what comes next"

The following Sunday, May 28th, the members will be chosen by lot during a Mass at the corresponding parish, a commissioning prayer service will be held prior to the first meeting. ST. PAUL CENTER FOR BIBLICAL THEOLOGY

By Dr. Scott Hahn: *Building His House*

Fifth Sunday of Easter (Year A)

Acts 6:1-7

Psalm 33:1-2, 4-5, 18-19

1 Peter 2:4-9

John 14:1-12 (see also "Exodus and Easter")

By His death, Resurrection and Ascension, Jesus has gone ahead to prepare a place for us in His Father's house.

His Father's house is no longer a temple made by human hands. It is the spiritual house of the Church, built on the living stone of Christ's body.

As Peter interprets the Scriptures in today's Epistle, Jesus is the "stone" destined to be rejected by men but made the precious cornerstone of God's dwelling on earth (see Psalm 118:22; Isaiah 8:14; 28:16).

Each of us is called to be a living stone in God's building (see 1 Corinthians 3:9,16). In this edifice of the Spirit, we are to be "holy priests" offering up "spiritual sacrifices" - all our prayer, work and intentions - to God. This is our lofty calling as Christians. This is why Christ led us out of the darkness of sin and death as Moses led the Israelites from bondage in Egypt.

God's covenant with Israel made them a royal and priestly people who were to announce His praises (see Exodus 19:6). By our faith in Christ's new covenant, we have been made heirs of this chosen race, called to glorify the Father in the temple of our bodies (see 1 Corinthians 6:19-20; Romans 12:1).

In today's First Reading, we see the spiritual house of the Church being built up, as the Apostles consecrate seven deacons so they can devote themselves more fully to the "ministry of the Word."

The Lord's Word is upright and all His works trustworthy, we sing in today's Psalm. So we can trust Jesus when He tells us never to be troubled, but to believe that His Word and works come from the Father.

His Word continues its work in the world through the Church. We see its beginnings today in Jerusalem. It is destined to spread with influence and power (see Acts 19:20), and to become the imperishable seed by which every heart is born anew (see 1 Peter 1:23).

Exodus and Easter

Israel's exodus from Egypt forms the background for many of the readings we hear in Easter.

On the Third Sunday, both the Gospel and Epistle describe Jesus "redeeming" or "ransoming" Israel (see Luke 24:21; 1 Peter 1:18). The Greek word in both is only used elsewhere to refer to Israel's redemption from Egypt (see Exodus 6:6; Deuteronomy 7:8). In the First Reading, Jesus is said to work "mighty deeds, wonders and signs" (see Acts 2:22) - the same words used to describe Moses' work (see Exodus 7:3; Deuteronomy 34:10-12).

Moses told the Israelites not to fear but to trust that God would go before and find them a place in the promised land (see Deuteronomy 1:29-32). Jesus uses the same words in the Fifth Sunday's Gospel. He also quotes Moses to claim that His words are God's words and His works are God's works (see Deuteronomy 18:18; 34:10-12).

There is much more exodus imagery in this month's readings. The point is to show us that Jesus' death and resurrection marked a new exodus (see Luke 9:31). The Christian life is like the sojourning of the Israelites in the wilderness. We have passed through the waters of Baptism and are now fed with bread from heaven as we make our way to the promised land of eternal life (see 1 Corinthians 10:1-4; 1 Peter 1:4).

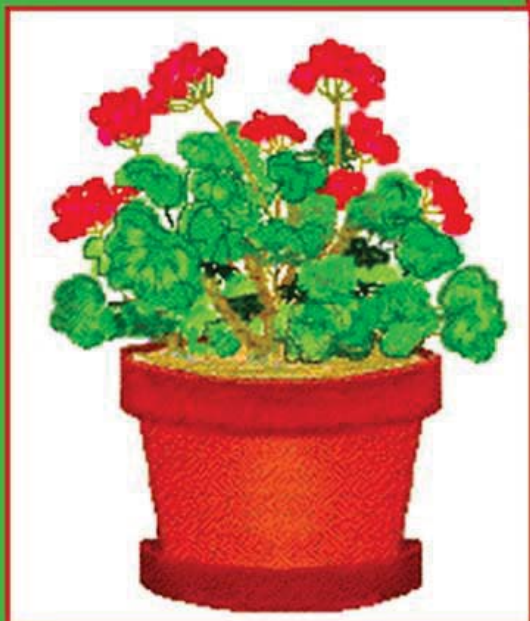

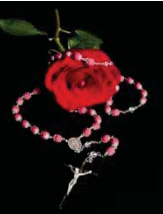


