

WELCOME



The Church is currently in the sixteenth week of 'Ordinary Time' - that part of the liturgical calendar that begins at the close of the Easter season and runs until the beginning of Advent. It would be easy to mistake ordinary for common or routine but it's meaning is much richer than that. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops describes Ordinary Time as a time for growth and maturation as disciples, a time in which the mystery of Christ is called to penetrate ever more deeply into our hearts.

The readings during this time focus on Jesus's ministry, particularly his teaching through parables. Last week, we heard the parable of the seed, which challenges us to consider when our hearts may be rocky or the soil too shallow to receive and nourish the seed of God's Word.

The Gospel this weekend speaks to us in a similar way with some everyday realities. Gardeners dealing with weeds growing among good plants, bakers knowing the importance of yeast in bread baking. Jesus uses parables to teach us lessons that we can identify with. At a deeper level, these parables highlight the importance of being discerning, of being patient, of allowing the life of God to grow and bear fruit in our lives.

These parables are sometimes called mirror parables, where Jesus asks us to take a good look at ourselves and evaluate our own spiritual condition.

"When the crop grew and bore fruit, the weeds appeared as well." What fruit does faith bear in my life? What weeds keep my life from being more fruitful?

"The field is the world." Where is the field that God is calling me to work? What labor can I give to help those around me?

"Then the righteous will shine like the sun in the kingdom of their Father." How can I glorify the Lord by my life? How can I better share my faith?

The parables last weekend and this, compare the Word of God as a seed to be planted in our hearts, with intentional fertilization and care. As I reflected on them. I started to think about the communal responses that we, the Body of Christ, recite each week at

Mass and their Scriptural origins. One of my favorites has always been from the Gospel of Matthew (8:8) where the centurion asks Jesus if he will heal his servant who has fallen ill. He tells the Lord, "I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof." We recite this every week before we receive the Blessed Sacrament. We are called to remember the love the centurion had for his servant and his humility as we approach the altar.

Other Scriptural references include the opening to the liturgy where the presider welcomes us with, "May the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all." That's a direct quote from Saint Paul in 2 Corinthians 13:14, calling forth God's presence and love within the church.

Most Sundays we sing the Gloria, "Glory to God in the highest and peace to His people on earth." That's from Luke 2:14 proclaiming that Christ saves us to bring glory to God. When God is glorified by man's willing worship and obedience, then there is peace on earth.

At every Mass we sing, "Holy, holy, holy, Lord, God of power and might" from Isaiah 6:30, at the beginning of the Liturgy of the Eucharist. The thrice repetition of Holy signifies our awe, wonder, praise and unworthiness before our Trinitarian God whose holiness we cannot fully understand.

The presider then says, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world" before we receive the Eucharist. That's what John the Baptist said to his followers in John 1:29. As the Mass concludes, we are "sent forth to bring the fruits of the Eucharist to the world" (usccb.org).


FIRST READING

GOSPEL

Mt 13: 24-43

Jesus proposed another parable to the crowds, saying: "The kingdom of heaven may be likened to a man who sowed good seed in his field. While everyone was asleep his enemy came and sowed weeds all through the wheat, and then went off. When the crop grew and bore fruit, the weeds appeared as well. The slaves of the householder came to him and said, 'Master, did you not sow good seed in your field? Where have the weeds come from?' He answered, 'An enemy has done this.' His slaves said to him, 'Do you want us to go and pull them up?' He replied, 'No, if you pull up the weeds you might uproot the wheat along with them. Let them grow together until harvest; then at harvest time I will say to the harvesters, "First collect the weeds and tie them in bundles for burning; but gather the wheat into my barn.""

He proposed another parable to them. "The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed that a person took and sowed in a field. It is the smallest of all the seeds, yet when full-grown it is the largest of plants. It becomes a large bush, and the 'birds of the sky come and dwell in its branches.'"

He spoke to them another parable. "The kingdom of heaven is like yeast that a woman took and mixed with three measures of wheat flour until the whole batch was leavened."


All these things Jesus spoke to the crowds in parables. He spoke to them only in parables, to fulfill what had been said through the prophet: I will open my mouth in parables, I will announce what has lain hidden from the foundation of the world.

Then, dismissing the crowds, he went into the house. His disciples approached him and said, "Explain to us the parable of the weeds in the field." He said in reply, "He who sows good seed is the Son of Man, the field is the world, the good seed the children of the kingdom. The weeds are the children of the evil one, and the enemy who sows them is the devil. The harvest is the end of the age, and the harvesters are angels. Just as weeds are collected and burned up with fire, so will it be at the end of the age. The Son of Man will send his angels, and they will collect out of his kingdom all who cause others to sin and all evildoers. They will throw them into the fiery furnace, where there will be wailing and grinding of teeth. Then the righteous will shine like the sun in the kingdom of their Father. Whoever has ears ought to hear."




