

Dear Faith Family,

I have been receiving many questions about how to deal with the tons of solicitation letters that are received by our parishioners from an incal-

culable number of "Catholic non-profits." My answer always starts with: "You are not obligated to send them anything, even if they send you a religious article."

(I also have to apologize. I received an email with this question and now I cannot find it to answer it. Sorry.)

How should you discern whom to help? First, did you know of them before you got the letter? Second, have you worked with or received aid from that group in the past? Third, do you benefit from their good work now? Fourth, do you know that they have done good work in your community? Fifth, is there a clear need that your support will be helpful for them to meet now? If the answer is no, throw out the letter and never think of it again. Yes, throw them away (or recycle). Do not bring them in a shopping bag to the Church. We will just throw them away.

When you are considering supporting a charity, know their mission and their impact. I prefer to support local organizations that I can see at work and those organizations that are brought to my attention by my Church. I also do my research that the organization is not promoting ideas or actions that are contrary to my conscience, as formed as a member of the Catholic Church. For instance, on the first weekend of September, our parishes will be holding a collection to support the Archdiocese of Honolulu and their works to support those who are suffering from the devastating fires. This is a worthy cause.

Let me change the subject, I am planning a trip to the Holy Land in 2025. I will be meeting with the Tour Company this Fall. I would like to know what level of interest there is before I meet with them. If you could fill-out the interest form

I would ask that you share your con-tact info and what time of year you would prefer. Note, summer is not an option due to the temperatures in Israel.

I pray that you are having a blessed end to your summer.

GOSPEL REFLECTION

Today's Gospel is so familiar that it may be easy to just let Jesus' question go quickly by without taking the time to answer him - "Who do you say that I am?" Will you respond with the conviction of Peter - "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God"? Or do you struggle to say who Christ is or if you know him at all?

Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God. How do you encounter the living God in your daily life? How can you live so as to share eternal life in heaven?

"The gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it." Where do you see evil present in the world? How can you resist the lure of evil?

"Whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven; and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven." What sinful behaviors should you work to avoid? What virtues should you seek to foster?

This Gospel invites everyone to take a few minutes today to consider what answer we give and to urge us to give time for the relationship with Jesus to grow. Taking time to honestly answer Jesus' question, will lead to our ability to say like Peter – "You are the Christ!"






