

Dear Parish Family,

This weekend the Church in the United States commemorates Catechetical Sunday. The Church celebrates the diligent work of all catechists. Those who

teach the Faith. What may first come to mind is a classroom with an adult at the front of the room while children sit at desks intently listening. That image does not reflect how the Faith is primality shared with the young of our faith family.

A better image is a family seated around the kitchen table engaging in conversation. The kitchen table, the "domestic altar," is where the Church envisions the Faith being taught first. It is here that we learn empathy. It is here we learn to be nourished and to be a servant for the common good. It is obvious then to say that parents are the first catechists. The first to witness to their children the love of Christ.

I get asked from time to time: "Where did you get your degrees?" The answer is St. John's Seminary in Brighton. Simple enough. If I am asked, "Where were you trained to be a priest?" The answer is different. My first seminary was "23 Greenacre Drive." My first teachers of theology were John and Rachel. It was in that split-level house painted green with ¾ of an acre of land and the many acres of swamp and forest that surrounded it where I first received training to be a priest. This is where I learned how to value others and work for their good and not just my own; a lesson often repeated. It is the first place I was taught Jesus loves me and has a plan for me.

It was in that house seated next to my Mother where I learned the value of a family table. The table from which we are nourished and formed. It is because of that experience that I came to understand the altar of the Church to be a "family table." Each Sunday we as a "family of families" gather around the Altar. It is truly integral to our formation and our upbringing. When we are not at Mass, we miss out on that which is essential to

our happiness and wholeness. This was reinforced in me when I was away at college. Several states away, I knew that my family was gathered around the table on Sunday being nourished and formed. I joined with them hundreds of miles away at the same table nourished by the same Lord.

Parents are the first and best catechists. My role as pastor is to support parents in their responsibilities as the first teachers of the faith for their children. May God Bless all catechists, especially parents.

MUSIC NOTES from Roger

Our hymnody continues this week with some more of my favorite "rousers" or "rafter rockers." Our opening hymn, "All Creatures of our God and King," set to the

tune Lasst uns erfreuen, comes to us from the German tradition of hymns from the 1600s. Its original first line from the German is "Let us most heartily rejoice." First published in 1623, the same tune has lasted through the ages in the same form as we sing today; that is, two sets of eight-note text phrases followed by two four-note Alleluia phrases, all of which is then followed by the final triple Alleluia refrain. We also sing this same hymn tune in this form to "Ye Watchers and ye Holy Ones."

Our recessional hymn is another grand hymn, this time from the English school of music. "Christ is Made the sure Foundation," set to the tune Westminster Abbey, hails from the same time period but from the pen of Henry Purcell who was first a tuner for the Westminster Abbey Organ and later at the ripe old age of twenty became the organist for that same grand worship space. We know one of his most popular organ pieces, which remains a frequent choice for weddings: *Trumpet Voluntary*. The text of this hymn was originally a Latin Monastic hymn from the 7th century. This combined hymn of text and music gained popularity after it was sung in the Abbey at the wedding of Princess Margaret in 1960, it was again used at the funeral of Elizabeth II at St. George's Chapel.

Whether you can sense the original intent and spirit of these hymns, recollect hearing them on a broadcast, or recall a special event from your family's past, there is no denying that these sung prayers are filled with joyous praise. Let us continue to raise together our voices in song to praise and thank our creator and God.

TWENTY FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Forgiveness – even the first disciples found it hard to be forgiving. When they asked Jesus, perhaps in frustration, how many times they were to be forgiving, Jesus does not soften his response. Rather he multiplies the number of times they are to be forgiving saying "not seven times but seven times seventyseven times." How fortunate are we that each time we seek out God's forgiveness in the Sacrament of Penance, we are never turned away. God's response is always one of mercy and compassion. To whom is God calling us to extend that same kind of forgiveness?

REFLECTION

What's in your heart?

- Not forgiving is an ingratitude. How could we not forgive others, when God has forgiven us so much? Another way of putting it, scripture says this week, is that if we do not show others forgiveness, it cannot be shown us. How does the reciprocity of forgiveness – forgive as you are forgiven, and as you want to be forgiven—show itself in your life and the lives of those around you?
- What are situations where it is necessary to keep forgiving, seventy times seven—that is, as many times as necessary?
- What does it mean to live entirely in the Lord, to live everything in the Lord?
- Are you "slow to anger," the way God is with you and others?

Since most funerals occur during the morning on weekdays, it is important to be available then, but some funerals are scheduled for a Saturday morning, so people with a work schedule during the week can help on a weekend.


Sir 27: 30-28: 7




GOSPEL
