

On October 4th 2023, the first session of the of the 16th General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops will be opened by the Holy Father, Pope Francis. The Synod is entitled "For a Synodal Church. # RADICAL SOLIDARITY



In the Gospel of John, shortly before he is to suffer his Passion, Jesus proclaims to his disciples: "I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another" (Jn 13:34). And it is love for one another that Jesus says will be the identifying characteristic of his disciples.

The Church's entire social doctrine is guided by the fundamental principle that every human life has innate dignity and incomparable value: "Every human being is the object of God's infinite tenderness, and he himself is present in their lives."[1] As disciples of Christ, we are called to make a sacrificial gift of ourselves for the sake of our neighbor, for "to love someone is to desire that person's good and to take effective steps to secure it."[2]

Fulfilling Christ's command to love one another takes shape in our practice of solidarity. Solidarity is the means by which we put our love for others into action, making the good of others our own. Solidarity "is not a feeling of vague compassion or shallow distress at the misfortunes of so many people... On the contrary, it is a firm and persevering determination to commit oneself to the common good...to the good of all and of each individual, because we are all really responsible for all."[3]

In reaction to the overturning of Roe v. Wade, some areas of the country now protect the child in the womb, while others are doing all they can to increase access to abortion. At this critical moment, we have been entrusted with new opportunities and new responsibilities to build a civilization of authentic love. Our culture claims to offer women so-called "choice," but ultimately abandons mothers to make tragic and painful decisions alone. We must lead the way in showing the alternative: "In firmly rejecting 'prochoice' it is necessary to become courageously 'pro woman,' promoting a choice that is truly in favor of women. ... The only honest stance, in these cases, is that of radical solidarity with the woman. It is not right to leave her alone." [4]

Experience shows that when a mother is supported, "she is even capable of heroism." [5] Radical solidarity compels us to come alongside vulnerable mothers in profound friendship, compassion, and support for both them and their preborn children. It requires us to address the fundamental challenges that lead an expectant mother to believe she is unable to welcome the child God has entrusted to her. We must do all we can to provide mothers, children, and families with the support they need to flourish. This cannot be accomplished by laws or policy alone, but requires the continual transformation of our own hearts, recognizing in every person the face of Christ, and placing their needs before our own.

Radical solidarity "refers to something more than a

few sporadic acts of generosity. It presumes the creation of a new mindset."[6] A culture of radical solidarity "gets involved by word and deed in people's daily lives... and it embraces human life, touching the suffering flesh of Christ in oth-

ers."[7] We each have our particular gifts, role, and obligation within the Body of Christ to help build a culture of life. We must honestly ask ourselves, "What radical, out-of-the-ordinary, actions have I taken to help a pregnant or parenting mother in need, or to proactively contribute to a culture of life in some other way?"

Inspired by Christ's own example of love, may we "enter fully into the fabric of society, sharing the lives of all, listening to their concerns, helping them materially and spiritually in their needs, rejoicing with those who rejoice, weeping with those who weep."[8] May we work together to bring about a culture of life through radical, sacrificial, Christ-like love.

#### SUNDAY REFLECTION

#### Twenty-sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In our second reading today St. Paul expresses the need for unity within the community of Philippi. "Do nothing out of selfishness or out of vainglory; rather, humbly regard others as more important than yourselves..." The same concern is of importance to each parish community. If we have Christ as our companion, his presence and love will keep us united to one another. St. Paul knew that a lack of unity, signs of divisiveness or a lack of harmony erodes the spirit of a community. What is Christ asking of us so that we can be united to him in our thinking and actions? This week, pray the prayer of St. Francis, whose feast we celebrate this week: "Lord, make me, [make us] instruments of your peace."

**MUSIC NOTES** from Roger Our Processional Hymn this week is "Crown Him with Many Crowns." This hymn is extremely well known and a favorite of many Christians. Did you know that it was published in over 633 hym-

nals? It was first published in 1868 and comes to us from the pen of George Elvey, who at the age of 19 became the organist at St. George's Chapel, Windsor, where he served until his 85th year. Its hymn tune name, Diademata, is derived from the Greek, meaning Crowns. There are 12 original verses for this hymn from two different poets. We usually see only the first 4 of them, and this week I chose to include the verse proclaiming Christ as the "Lord of Peace." In fact, the theme of "peace" will be seen (and heard) in music throughout the Masses this weekend, in honor of Wednesday's Feast of St. Francis of Assisi who so often is associated with the concept of peace in nature and the Church. Therefore, we also are singing "The Prayer of St Francis" at weekend Masses, asking God to "Make us a channel of your peace." In addition, at the 12:00 noon Mass at St Agnes, the Parish Choir will sing the anthem "Grant Us Peace" by Felix Mendelssohn. I look forward to hearing your voices raised in prayer this weekend, as we pray to the "Lord of Peace" to help us bring about peace in our lives and in our communities.
