

# WORLD MISSION SUNDAY



Pope Francis, in his message for today, World Mission Sunday, reflects on the theme "Hearts on fire, feet on the move," based on the story of the disciples who encounter Jesus on their way to Emmaus (cf. Lk 24:13-35). He invites all of us to "set out once more, illumined by our encounter with the risen Lord and prompted by his Spirit. Let us set out again with burning hearts, with our eyes open and our feet in motion. Let us set out to make other hearts burn with the word of God, to open the eyes of others to Jesus in the Eucharist, and to invite everyone to walk together on the path of peace and salvation that God, in Christ, has bestowed upon all humanity."

On World Mission Sunday, we join our Holy Father in supporting his missions. As we pray and respond here at home, we share in those celebrations taking place in every parish and school throughout the world. *Together, through our prayers and financial support, we bring the Lord's mercy and concrete help to the most vulnerable communities in the Pope's missions.* 

In a world where so much divides us, World Mission Sunday rejoices in our unity as missionaries by our Baptism, as it offers each one of us an opportunity to support the life-giving presence of the Church among the poor and marginalized in more than 1,111 mission dioceses.

# STUDY WITH THE VILLAGES



Ordinary time in the church is a time of growth. During this time, the Gospel reading often focuses Jesus teaching through the use of parables. Jesus favored parables – short allegories featuring people, places, and things familiar to ordinary listeners – to get his point across. Typically, they were about the kingdom of God, standing in stark contrast to the current world. "Families created their own parables based on one of three prompts:

The kingdom of heaven is like... Trying to be like Jesus is like... *Prayer is like...* 

#### Here are a few examples of what they created:

Trying to be like Jesus is like Mr. Potato Head. Mr. Potato Head can make many faces, emotions, and his parts can be placed in many ways. Despite what is on the outside of Mr. Potato head, he holds all of his beautiful parts on the inside. The moral is trying to be like Jesus is seeing beyond the appearances and what is on the surface and seeing what is on the

inside, love, kindness, and compassion.





Prayer is like talking to your favorite stuffed animals. They are cuddly and cute, and are good listeners. They are comforting and calming, they will not tell your secrets and they are always there for you. Just like God is always there for you, listening to you and helping and caring for you. He will never turn his back on you!

Trying to be like Jesus is like an empty bowl. When you start your life, you start as an empty bowl. When you start to be like Jesus you start getting love, light, and memories that are sweet and bitter.

When you are full of love and light vour life becomes a gift.



#### GOSPEL

Mt 22: 15-21

The Pharisees went off and plotted how they might entrap Jesus in speech. They sent their disciples to him, with the Herodians, saying, "Teacher, we know that you are a truthful man and that you teach the way of God in accordance with the truth.
