

rificial giving. We will be publishing a report when we have the data to demonstrate the impact. Thank you!

This Advent, I invite you to join the Increased Prayer Program. Over the last months, the unrest throughout the world, and in our own community, has caused many of us distress. We need prayer to confront these "interesting times." The specifics of the Increased Prayer Program are shared in this bulletin. The basics are this: each week of Advent, we will have the opportunity to participate in 40 hours of Eucharistic Exposition and Adoration. All that is needed is one adorer an hour to make this happen. I invite you to choose at least one hour to be in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament. Each week will have a specific intention. The First week's intention will be peace. There will be specifics times for families to participate with help available for families to teach children about Exposition and Adoration.

I hope that you will choose to join me before the Blessed Sacrament. When I first experienced Adoration, I was apprehensive and self-conscious. Now, my visits with Christ are full of peace and clarity. This is why I have stated that I would like to open a 24-hour Eucharistic Adoration Chapel. When I find myself getting distracted, I repeat to myself: "Stay with me, remain with me, watch and pray." I find these words calm me down and focus me. In my mind's eye at those moments, I find myself sitting in the Olive Grove outside of the Church of All Nations, in Jerusalem. That is, I see myself with Jesus on the Mount of Olives. Before the Blessed Sacrament I can join with Christ as he has joined with me. I invite you to experience that joy and peace.

#### November 18th is World Day for the Prevention of and Healing from Child Sexual Exploitation, Abuse, and Violence

The Archdiocese of Boston joins the United Nations in recognizing November 18th as the World Day for the Prevention of and Healing from Child Sexual Exploitation, Abuse, and Violence.

Child abuse is a far too frequent occurrence in our society. The numbers are staggering, and the lifelong impact can be profound. We must do all that is possible to intervene - preventing abuse, interrupting and reporting it when it is happening, and helping heal those who have been abused. As a diocese, we do this by screening and training our clergy, volunteers, and employees, and by training our youth how to recognize and respond to risks and get help when something is wrong. We provide targeted pastoral care for those who were abused by clergy or other representatives within our church to assist them with healing. We ask everyone to join these efforts through prayer, kind and compassionate outreach to those who are impacted by abuse, and full participation in our abuse prevention efforts.
