
MUSIC NOTES from Roger

A reminder that during this season of Advent, we are using new musical settings of the Holy, Holy and the Lamb of God. These settings are from the Mass of St Philip Neri written in 2011 by Paul Jernberg who lives in Lancaster, MA. You'll find that the settings are very simple and straight-forward to sing. In 2011 Paul Jernberg said he "sensed a great need for worthy new settings of the Mass that would correspond to the heightened beauty and integrity of the new translation." He explains that "this music

can best be understood as an integration of two perennial traditions: that of Gregorian chant in the West and that of Byzantine (particularly Slavic) harmonized chant in the East." This setting has been enthusiastically received in parishes all over the US, Canada and England. One reviewer noted of the Mass: "its capacity to aid worshippers to enter more deeply and prayerfully into the reality of Christ's presence in the liturgy."

I find these settings to be very prayerful in their sound and spirit. They are easy to approach and very singable to incorporate into our worship. I hope you enjoy learning them and hearing them sung as they add a new spirit-filled musical change in our liturgy as we move through the Advent season and begin our Increased Prayer Program.

The third Sunday of Advent will be here soon, so don't forget to mark your calendars:



Is 40: 1-5, 9-11



A voice cries out: In the desert prepare the way of the LORD! Make straight in the wasteland a highway for our God! Every valley shall be filled in, every mountain and hill shall be made low; the rugged land shall be made a plain, the rough country, a broad valley. Then the glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all people shall see it together; for the mouth of the LORD has spoken.

Go up on to a high mountain, Zion, herald of glad tidings; cry out at the top of your voice, Jerusalem, herald of good news! Fear not to cry out and say to the cities of Judah: Here is your God! 
As it is written in Isaiah the prophet: "Behold, I am sending my messenger ahead of you; he will prepare your way. People of the whole Judean countryside and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem were going out to him and were being baptized by him in the Jordan River as they acknowledged their sins. John was clothed in camel's hair, with a leather belt around his waist. He fed on locusts and wild honey. And this is what he proclaimed: "One mightier than I is coming after me. I am not worthy to stoop and loosen the thongs of his sandals. I have baptized you with water; he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit."






