### **FOURTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME**

Mark makes clear in today's Gospel that Jesus spoke with a different kind of authority, an authority or confidence that arose from his own prayer and personal relationship with the Father. Everything Jesus did, his words, his deeds, his response to those in need, all sprang from that relationship. This gospel gives us a little push to reflect on our own words and actions. During this coming week take time to speak to Christ about his relationship with the Father and to consider whether what we say and do arises from our relationship with God. Ask for the grace to speak with the confidence of Christ about his/our Father!

Our offertory hymn this week, "There is a Balm in Gilead," is a traditional African American Spiritual. Its origin is unclear as it comes to us mostly from oral tradition; however, in the 19th century a version of the re-

frain can be found in Washington Glass's hymn, "The Sinners Cure."

Gilead is an Old Testament reference to a mountainous region east of the Jordan River. Gilead was known for having skilled physicians and an ointment made from a particular gum tree of that area (Jeremiah 8: 22). God tells the People of Israel that though they may believe in the healing powers of the balm, it does not heal the spirit. The lyrics of this spiritual pull from this image of healing, and refer more directly to the New Testament concept of salvation through Jesus Christ. God sends his son into the world to become our balm in Gilead, our spiritual medicine, our Saviour.

We sing this song with that assurance in our faith that no matter our circumstances or hardships, Jesus' love will endure and bring us to eternal life with Him.



# EVANGELIZING DURING LENT

During the season of Lent, Catholics visibly practice their faith in unique ways that can catch the attention of non-Catholics. These practices then become opportunities for evangelization. We should be ready to explain why we do what we do during Lent for our own sakes and for the sakes of those who want to learn about Catholicism.

# THE ASH WEDNESDAY ASHES: WHY DO YOU HAVE DIRT ON YOUR FOREHEAD?

First, ashes are a symbol for the need for forgiveness in the Old and New Testaments. Ashes on Ash Wednesday remind us that we need forgiveness from God. Second, ashes remind us that God created us from earth and that our bodies will return to the earth after death, but our souls are destined to be with God forever. (The ashes come from burning palms from the previous year's Palm Sunday celebration.)

### **ABSTAINING FROM MEAT ON FRIDAYS:**

Why can't you have a burger today? Abstaining from meat on Fridays is a small sacrifice for us to make to remember the great sacrifice that Jesus made for us on the cross on Good Friday. In addition, we need to pray for a clean heart, the readiness to follow God's will, and a connection to others who are suffering, especially the poor.

# GIVING SOMETHING UP FOR LENT: WHY DO YOU GIVE SOMETHING UP FOR LENT?

Giving up something for Lent strengthens our love for Christ and our resistance to temptations to sin. This practice really does not mean much, however, unless we become more loving persons. Lent gives us the opportunity to pray more and to perform additional acts of kindness and service.


# PALM SUNDAY: WHY DO YOU GET PALM BRANCHES AT CHURCH?

We take palms home because they remind us of the story behind Palm Sunday in the Bible. Jesus rides into Jerusalem and people put palm branches on the road in front of him as a sign of honor as they call him a king. Palm Sunday is a day to honor Christ as king but also to remember that he is a humble king, riding on a donkey.

# GOOD FRIDAY: WHY DO YOU GO TO CHURCH ON GOOD FRIDAY AFTERNOON?

On Good Friday, we go to church in the afternoon to honor Jesus' hours of suffering on the cross before he died. We reflect on Jesus' love for us and follow the story of Jesus' final hours as we pray the Stations of the Cross.
