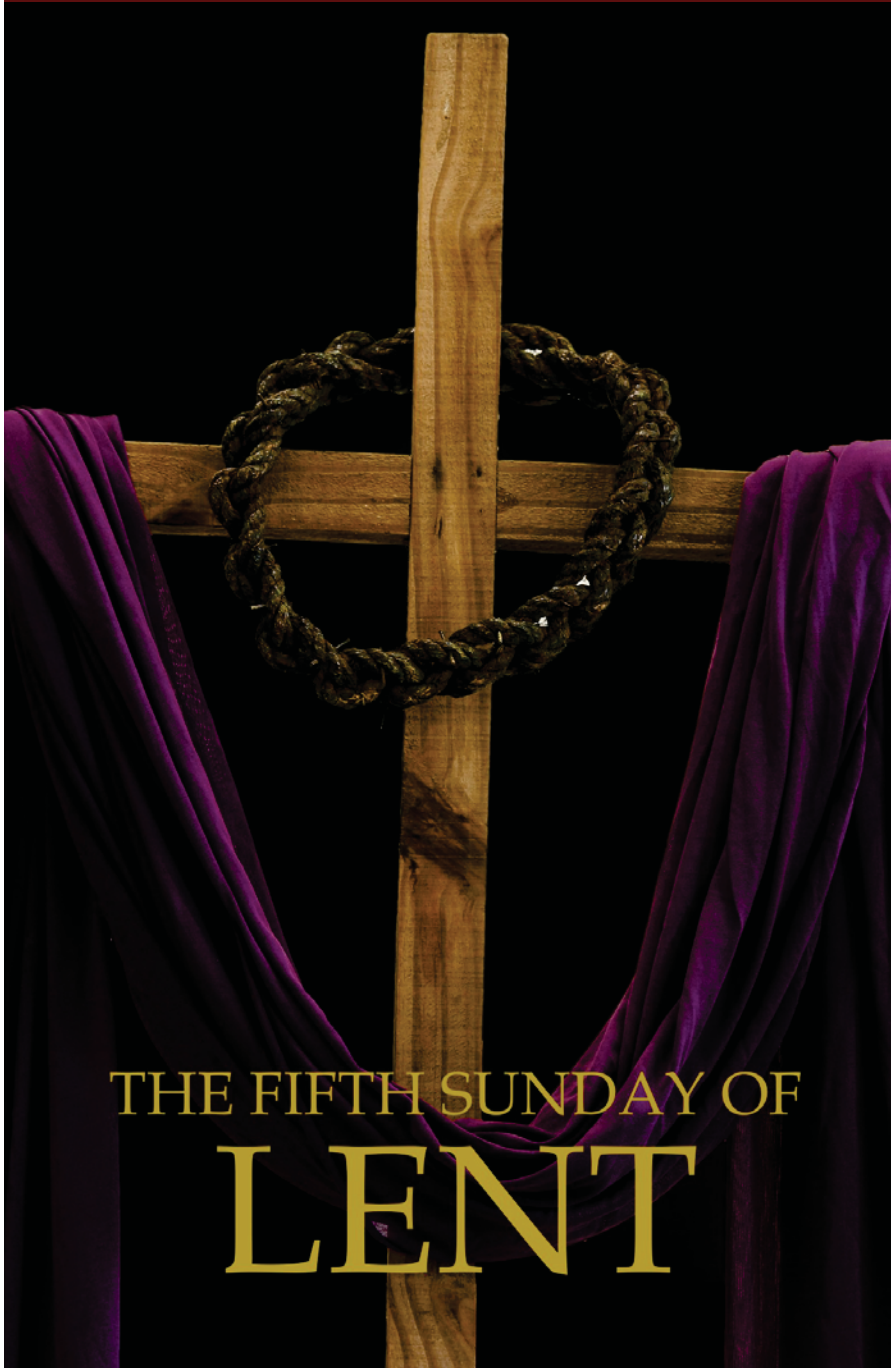

ST. JOSEPH A PATRON SAINT FOR THE FAMILY

Feast Day March 19th

"Make him [St. Joseph] the patron of your family and you will soon have tangible proof of his protecting hand." ~ St. Peter Julian Eymard

Our Father in heaven entrusted St. Joseph with the mighty task of being foster father to His only begotten Son, and Joseph dutifully accepted despite potential persecution and danger. St. Joseph is a model of protection, patience, spiritual surrender, and humble docility. Who better then to entrust to our families for guidance and intercession.

St. Joseph's paternal instruction would have been instrumental in the quiet development and education of his precious Son. Jesus didn't begin his ministry until age 30. Consider the moments of earthly father and Son together in the workshop... learning the trade of carpentry ... learning the ways of being a prayerful and obedient man of faith.

Consider the spiritual example St. Joseph set for his Son. At twelve, Jesus witnessed Joseph's example of fatherly love, prayerful contemplation, and presence in temple.

But perhaps one of the most important and impactful examples St. Joseph set for his Son and for the world was his humble docility in the face of the Lord. Joseph kept Mary for his wife, despite her unexpected pregnancy. The humility to follow the Lord's instruction in such a situation given the societal repercussions is incredible. He followed the Lord's guidance through Egypt for safety of his family.

O Most holy Joseph, glorious Patriarch, chosen by God as the head and protector of the Holy Family, deign to take our families, also, under your fatherly protection and care.

OUR LENTEN MISSION

Pope Francis recently hosted the bishops of the Catholic Church for a Synod on Synodality. If you paid attention to Catholic media, you would likely have gotten the impression that the Synod was about different agendas in the Church trying to take over, fight for power, and change Church teaching on controversial topics. This is not what Synodality is nor is it what the Synod was about.

The 2 Greek words that make up Synod are syn (together) and hodos (meaning way or journey). The purpose of synodality is to journey with someone. Saint John Chrysostom says, 'Church and Synod are synonymous' - inasmuch as the Church is nothing other than the 'journeying together' of God's flock along the paths of history towards the encounter with Christ the Lord. It's about listening to each other, "the disciple listens."

IMAGINE A COLLABORATIVE...

- fully alive and growing with a clear sense of mission to form new disciples of Jesus Christ, renew the community around it and witness to the love of God in inspiring ways.
- filled with engaged parishioners deepening their relationship with God and sharing their faith with others.
- where everyone, regardless of their background, current state in life or relationship with God and His Catholic Church feel a strong sense of belonging and that there is a place for them in the parish.
- in which Masses and liturgies are so vibrant that the "Sunday experience" is transformative for all - old, young, regular parishioners and guests.
- that looks beyond its church building and parking lot to bring the healing grace of Jesus Christ to the world and address with greater intentionality the ills of our age.

PARISH SPIRITUAL RENEWAL

Parishes are families of faith where we grow spiritually - both personally and as a community; where we experience a profound and personal encounter with Jesus Christ through His Church; where we can fulfill our desire for mission and service; where we need to feel welcome, loved and a deep sense of belonging.

Our parish formation programs and activities were created for a different age, not built to respond creatively to the needs of current generations. It is a time for parish renewal and transformation. Based on what has worked in transformed parishes throughout the world, we know that the following five strategies will help our parishes meet the challenge of our "new missionary age":

- New kerygmatic entry points
- Radical hospitality
- Vibrant and transformative liturgies
- Readiness-based faith formation
- Charity and outreach

How do we make it all happen?

The work of Collaborative renewal is carried out by missionary disciples who are on fire with the Holy Spirit, collaborating with the pastor in inviting others to a life of faith, in building the parish community and in serving others in need. Parish renewal depends on parishioners taking up the call to co-responsibility alongside the pastor and staff.

Every parishioner who is willing to listen to others, who is open about their faith story, who intentionally invites others to grow in their faith, who prays for and with others, and who is welcoming to all helps to foster a Culture of Evangelization, which is essential to renewal. We evangelize by being authentic followers of Jesus who are willing to share our lived experience of how Jesus transformed our life because we want to help someone know of God's love and have their own encounter with Jesus.

In the remaining days of Lent, pray for the grace to make the necessary changes in your life to live in imitation of Christ.






