

If you would be able to lend your time, the 75th Anniversary Committee is actively meeting and would appreciate your assistance. You also will have the opportunity to participate in the commemorative Ad Book that is a major project of the committee. The net proceeds from the Ad Book will be used to repair the St. Camillus Bell Tower. Let's work together to let those bells ring out.





CPARL PILGRIMAGE REFLECTION

I traveled with Father Marc and 43 other pilgrims to Lisbon, Fatima and Porto in Portugal, Santiago de Compostela and Burgos in Spain and Lourdes and Paris in France from June 8th-June 18th.

The most meaningful parts of our pilgrimage for me were the evening Rosaries and candlelight processions in Fatima and Lourdes, Father Marc concelebrating Masses at Santiago Cathedral (the burial site of St. James the Apostle) and the grotto in Lourdes where Mary appeared to St. Bernadette, other daily Masses celebrated by Father Marc assisted by altar server Ian Mansfield, our visit to Notre Dame Cathedral of Paris and the daily Rosaries on our bus rides through Portugal, Spain and France.


The pilgrimage was a chance to interact with fellow parishioners and members from other parishes. In the process, many new friendships were formed over our shared experiences.

During our time in Paris, we were able to visit Notre Dame Cathedral of Paris which took 182 years to build beginning in 1163 but was almost destroyed during the devastating fire of April 15, 2019. Incredibly, it was rebuilt in only 5 years and re-opened to the public on the feast of the Immaculate Conception on December 8, 2024. We also visited the Eiffel Tower and sampled great French cuisine. Some of us had the chance to visit the Miraculous Medal Chapel where the incorrupt body of St. Catherine Laboure, who designed the Miraculous Medal, is buried.

However, the most meaningful part of the pilgrimage for me was a visit to Omaha Beach in Normandy, France. This was the bloodiest of the June 6, 1944 D-Day beach invasions with 2,400 U.S. troops either killed, wounded or missing. Visiting the Normandy American Cemetery and Memorial was a very moving experience as it is hallowed ground where over 9,000 troops who served in World War II, including many who participated in the D-Day Normandy Landings, are buried. As we entered the cemetery, our Tour Guide told us we were on American soil and the cemetery as well as others in France are maintained by the people of France to thank allied troops such as those from the United States for helping to liberate their country.

Throughout our 10-day Pilgrimage, it was a time for prayer, reflection and growing stronger in my faith and I am grateful to Father Marc and Paul Dube of Dube Travel for providing a very meaningful experience.

FEAST OF SAINT CAMILLUS



A HISTORY OF SAINT CAMILLUS PARISH

The history of Saint Camillus Parish began on July 18th, 1950 when Archbishop Richard Cushing established Saint Camillus Parish. The land chosen for the Church was farmland in the Arlington Heights area that bordered on Belmont.

The first Pastor was Father John E. Sullivan. Through the work of several founding parishioners, Father Sullivan was able to oversee the construction of the first Saint Camillus Church. On Palm Sunday, April 29th, 1951, the new Church was blessed and the first Mass offered for these dedicated people who came to rejoice and give thanks to God for their new spiritual home.

As a result of the dedicated ministry of Father Sullivan and several enthusiastic parochial vicars, Saint Camillus Parish grew in spirituality and numbers. The consequence of this growth necessitated the building of our present beautiful edifice. On October 2nd, 1961, Richard Cardinal Cushing dedicated the lovely Church on the same farmland where he had established the Parish in 1950. Saint Camillus Parish has experienced all the social and ecclesiastical changes that have occurred during the past forty years.

In 1975, the Church celebrated its Silver Jubilee. Monsignor Sullivan and two parochial vicars were able to rejoice on this happy occasion.

Unfortunately, conditions would change and Saint Camillus would experience the shortage of priestly vocations in the Archdiocese.

In 1976, Monsignor Sullivan would retire and be replaced by Father William Anderson who now had one assistant. In 1989, Father Anderson retired and was replaced by Father Paul Rouse who had no assistant.

In 1995, Father Rouse was transferred and replaced by Father James E. O'Leary who served the parish for 23 years until our present Pastor, Father Marc Bishop arrived in 2018.

In 1998, the spirit of Saint Camillus, Patron of the sick, was enkindled by the arrival of two student priests from the order of Saint Camillus in India. The patron's mission now took on a new dimension. Appropriately, Saint Camillus was an aging Parish with many parishioners experiencing sickness. Volunteers came forward to bring Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament to the sick in the hospital and homebound members of the parish.

As the new millennium began, Saint Camillus Parish celebrated its Golden Anniversary. Its motto was:

> "Fifty years of love and joy, Fifty years of sharing, Fifty years of tears and laughter, Fifty years of caring."

We now find ourselves in the new century, the new millennium, the new era of spiritual renewal.






FLOOD RELIEF COLLECTION
