

This Sunday, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. In Boston, it is also the titular feast of our Cathedral — unique in not being dedicated to a saint or the Holy Trinity, but to the Holy Cross itself, the central symbol of our faith. In the Old Testament, Moses lifted a bronze serpent on a pole to bring healing. In the New Testament, Christ was lifted on the Cross, showing perfect obedience to God and bringing salvation to all. As Christians, we are each called to carry our own cross daily — through illness, hardship, or personal struggles — as a way of living out our faith. Today, we give special witness to our mission as members of the Church in Boston, united under the sign of the Cross.

WALKING WITH FAMILIES IN FAITH





This summer, Meredith and I both participated as leaders in the Faith and Family Life Catholic Ministry Workshops in Chicago. Here are some take-aways.

One of the great joys of my ministry as SCOTT MORIN Director of Evangelization is walking with DIRECTOR OF families on their journey of faith, especially parents who are trying to pass that faith

on to their children. The desire is there, but many parents feel uncertain about how to start. Maybe they didn't grow up with faith being lived out at home. Perhaps they feel unqualified, as if they need a theology degree to raise children in the Church. Maybe they feel disconnected or even unworthy because life has led them away from regular church attendance. But here's the good news: they are not alone. At CPARL, we are committed to supporting parents and families together.

A Collaborative That Walks Together

As a Church, we are all called by our baptism to share in the mission of making disciples. That mission starts in the home. The Church calls the family "the domestic Church" because it's in the family that children first learn who God is and how to follow God. Our collaborative is here to nurture, encourage, and equip parents in this sacred work. Supporting families isn't a side program - it's part of our whole culture. Every ministry, every event, every homily has the potential to uplift our parents and help them grow as disciples. Here are just a few of the ways CPARL is intentionally investing in families:

- Parish Leadership Clergy, staff, and ministry leaders continually discern how to accompany parents better and support adult faith formation. We're not just talking about logistics; we're crafting a culture that welcomes and walks with adults at every stage of the journey.
- **Ministry Formation** Leaders are trained to think beyond events and into relationships: How are we helping people grow closer to Christ? How are we meeting them where they are? How are we inviting them deeper into the life of the Church?
- Lenten Missions and Retreats We offer practical formation to help people feel confident in inviting others into faith, starting with their own families.

A New Way to Welcome Parents

Picture this: a parent walks into the lower church hall for their child's First Communion meeting. They're overwhelmed - juggling jobs, sports practices, meals,

and maybe some guilt for not having been to church in a while. They love their kids and want them to know God, but they're unsure of what to expect... or what might be expected of them. We've reimagined this first step.

Instead of an information dump or a classroom lecture, we call it "the Visit." It's not a meeting - it's a conversation. It's a chance for parents to be heard, to share their hopes and struggles, and to know they're not being judged. We let them know: You belong here. We're glad you came. We're walking with you.

It All Comes Back to Jesus

Many of our parents didn't grow up with a living relationship with Jesus. They may have learned about Him, but never felt close to Him. That's where we begin. We introduce them - not just to information - but to Jesus Himself. Through storytelling, Scripture, conversation, and prayer, we help parents encounter the living God who loves them and is calling them back into relationship.

Equipping Parents - Not Expecting Perfection

Parenting doesn't come with a manual. Most parents are just doing their best, one day at a time, and hoping they're getting it right. At CPARL, we don't expect perfection. What we offer is companionship, encouragement, and practical tools - how to pray as a family, how to discuss God at the dinner table, and how to live the faith even in busy, chaotic seasons of life. We help parents become not just teachers of the faith, but witnesses people who live it out in their own imperfect but faithful

Rooted in Relationship

If there's one theme that ties all of this together, it's relationship. Over the past several years, we've been intentionally building strong, trusting relationships with parents, with leaders, catechists, and with one another. We take time to listen, to understand where people are spiritually, and to discern together where God is leading them next. Ministry flows from that kind of trust and connec-


CONGRATULATIONS!
