In last week's Pilot, our Archbishop wrote a poignant and timely column about the horrible violence we have been experiencing as a nation. In it he wrote a line that resonated with me: "The

darkness that lurks in the human heart has been on display to a degree that the horrific has become ordinary." Yes, horrific. We—as Catholic Christians cannot give in to the trend to be outraged and act outrageously. We need to embrace the Hope we know in Jesus Christ, who suffered and died for us.

It is also an opportunity to ask God to heal our community from hate and anger. I invite all to attend this Mass to pray for their personal needs for healing; and our need to heal as a nation from the trickster's influences that are sowing hate and chaos. Following the Mass, there will be time for individual prayer and the laying on of hands by a priest.

SAFE ENVIRONMENT FOR CHILDREN

At the Catholic Parishes of Arlington, we are committed to providing a safe and nurturing environment for everyone, as well as to the spiritual, emotional, and physical well-being of minors and vulnerable adults who participate in activities within or sponsored by our parishes.

All Liturgical Ministers and parishioners who participate in service activities must complete a yearly Criminal Offender Record Information (CORI) form and comply with the Code of Conduct for Volunteers of the Archdiocese of Boston.

All employees and parishioners aged 18 years and older who participate in parish-sponsored activities involving work with children, youth, or the elderly must complete a one-time VIRTUS Protecting God's Children workshop. The training teaches participants how to ensure a safe environment at the parish, school, and off-site activities, recognize and respond to possible abuse indicators, and report concerns about potential abuse.

THE MONTH OF THE ROSARY

The month of October is dedicated in a special way to our Blessed Mother and is often referred to as the "rosary month." This name is derived from the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, celebrated on October 7th. The feast's origins lie in the victory at

the Battle of Lepanto, where Pope St. Pius V had a miraculous victory against the Ottoman Empire on October 7, 1571. Legend tells us that Pope Pius V encouraged his troops to pray the rosary before the battle. He believed that the intercession of our Blessed Mother was the key to saving Rome from invasion. In honor of the Blessed Mother, he designated October 7th as the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary.


The Rosary is a simple yet profound prayer that many people cherish as their favorite form of devotion. This devotion is also loved by many saints. In 1978, shortly after his election, St. John Paul II remarked, "The Rosary is my favorite prayer. A marvelous prayer! Marvelous in its simplicity and depth..." St. Padre Pio also had a deep devotion to the rosary, referring to it as the best weapon against evil. Within our parish, there are various rosary groups, such as the Rosary Group, which meets every Tuesday at 7:00 PM at St. Agnes, the Marian Monday Prayer Group that gathers every three months at St. Camillus, and the Daily Rosary Group that prays after the 7:00 AM Mass at St. Agnes.

Praying the rosary is often misunderstood as a focus solely on Mary. However, by praying the rosary, we are also contemplating the life of Christ. St. John Paul II emphasizes this connection in his Apostolic Letter, Rosarium Virginis Mariae, stating, "To recite the Rosary is nothing other than to contemplate with Mary the face of Christ." He also noted in the same letter, "the face of the Son belongs to Mary. It was in her womb that Christ was formed, receiving from her a human resemblance." A key aspect of the rosary is found in the first part of the Hail Mary prayer, where we recite, "Blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus." This phrase underscores our belief that praying the rosary is ultimately about reflecting on Jesus with Mary.

Mary holds a special place as our Mother and the Mother of all humankind. Her compassion for our needs and her constant intercession on our behalf remind us of her protective role. Throughout many of her apparitions, she has encouraged the faithful to pray the rosary, specifically to foster peace in the world. Various pontiffs have affirmed that reciting the rosary serves as a powerful prayer for peace, especially in times of turmoil.


In light of the current global turmoil, with ongoing unrest in the Middle East and rising gun violence in our country, turning to our Blessed Mother for guidance through the rosary seems more appropriate. Pope Leo XIII, in his encyclical, Supremi Apostolatus Officio, describes the rosary as a formidable weapon against the evils afflicting society. As we navigate this unprecedented time marked by violence and injustice, let us embrace the rosary as a means to intercede with our Blessed Mother for peace and justice across the world.

CPARL FY25 FINANCIAL REPORT



Every October, our Collaborative Finance Councils provide a recap of the previous fiscal year performance. On this page and the following, you will see a recap of their report for St. Agnes and St. Camillus.

We humbly request that you spend time reviewing this information as we prepare for our annual Offertory Re-Commitment.

We ask that you prayerfully consider your sacrificial contribution to our faith family. **Thank you**.

Dear Parishioners:

The accompanying statements represent the financial condition of The Catholic Parishes of Arlington (CPARL) for the year ending June 30th, 2025 and the budget for fiscal 2026. This annual report is presented by the Parish Finance Councils which provide financial oversight and advice to our Pastor on money matters. We hope that they will help you understand how your contributions and gifts to CPARL are used and accounted for at each parish and will encourage your continued generosity. Please feel confident that financial stewardship is very much a priority of our Collaborative.

Saint Agnes Parish ended the 2025 fiscal year with net operating income of \$235,796. This was the result of very generous bequests received during the year and significant gains from our investments, even though the Offertory Collection was lower than the previous year. Reserves (including cash, investments, and money due to us) grew to \$1,474,763, providing the parish with further financial stability.

Saint Camillus Parish ended the 2025 fiscal year with net operating income of \$30,369. Sustained Offertory Receipts and Rental Income as well as strong support of the Grand Annual appeal helped the parish maintain a positive operating cash flow. Reserves (including cash, investments, and money due to us) held steady at \$825,878.

Each parish was able to control its operating expenses through more efficient management and better allocation of central expenses among our Collaborative parish entities. In addition, several necessary capital improvement projects were also completed at both parishes.

CPARL FY25 FINANCIAL REPORT



At Saint Agnes, significant repairs were made to the Church steeple and additional security improvements were implemented in the Church. The HVAC system underwent much needed maintenance and repair. A stone walkway was also built around the Blessed Mother Statue outside the Church. The total cost of these projects was \$206, 734. Your response to our Grand Annual appeal helped fund approximately half of these expenses.

At Saint Camillus, internal Church design and site assessment studies were undertaken at a cost of \$10,947.

Projects being considered for the current year include repairs to the external doors and replacement of the foyer floors at Saint Agnes Church. The bell tower at Saint Camillus Church needs critical and substantial repair; a special fundraising effort has been launched for this purpose.

The Grand Annual collection takes place on the weekend of October 25th– October 26th, 2025. Once again, we are requesting that each working person donate \$350 to the first part of the Grand Annual Collection. We hope that those who are able, will respond by being even more generous. We also recognize the need to strengthen the regular Offertory Collection which is the primary source of operating income for our parishes.

Once again, we encourage your prayerful consideration and support of our Offertory and Grand Annual Collection. The success of our parish activities and programs also depends, in large measure, on the dedicated team of volunteers who generously contribute their time and talent; we strongly solicit your participation. Our clergy and staff remain deeply committed to our Collaborative mission. Together, we look forward to another fruitful year at CPARL.






