

Dear Faith Family,

Over the last several weeks, we have been sharing the financial and pastoral assessments and data of our Collaborative. We have seen that our parishes are growing when measured by Mass attendance and overall programing.

When people visit our churches, they often comment that they feel welcome. This is a great complement as it is the attribute that most witnesses to our community's spirit. Our Ushers and Ministers of Hospitality certainly lead the way. Please consider being an Usher or Minister of Hospitality. We need more to give of their time at one Mass a month to be that welcoming face so many need right now. For more information or to sign up email info@cparl.org.

Our offertory is flat. We have more registered parishioners, yes. But, we don't see them every weekend due to trips and second homes. Please consider making your offer online; it ensures a consistent offering. The average parishioner makes an offering to their home parish 32 to 38 times a year. Those that give online give 52 weeks a year and support special collections. This consistency is needed for the parishes to meet the growing demands of utilities and maintenance for our many older buildings. I am grateful to those who remember the parish in their estate planning. Because of a recent bequest, we can repair and recondition all the exterior doors of St. Agnes Church. St. Camillus needs to be less reliant on rental income; rental income should be to support plant improvements - not normal operations.

Catholic education is a blessing that should be available to each family in our Collaborative. Our school produces high quality graduates that are excelling at their universities and fields of work. I repeatedly hear from college administrators that our students are intellectually, spiritually, and socially ready for higher education. If you would like to learn more about St. Agnes Elementary School and Arlington Catholic High School, open houses are scheduled for Thursday, October 23rd at 6:00 PM and Sunday, November 16th at 10:00 AM. Come and see what it means to "grow up on Medford Street."

I thank you for your prayerful support of the Catholic Parishes of Arlington. Together we can do more great things for our community. I have ideas for more social outreach, but I would like to hear your thoughts too.



Each year, we take part in our Offertory Recommitment Campaign – a time to prayerfully reflect on our blessings and renew our commitment to support our parish community. Thanks to your generosity, we have stabilized our operating income and established a strong foundation for continued growth.

As part of our ongoing stewardship, the first phase of the Grand Annual Collection will begin on the weekend of October 25-26, 2025. This collection remains an essential financial resource for our parish, and we once again ask every working member of our community to contribute \$350 toward this effort.

We also invite you to prayerfully consider your offertory giving for the next twelve months. Making a non-binding pledge helps you be intentional in your sacrificial giving and allows the Collaborative to plan responsibly. Together, as a faith family, we continue this annual journey of reflection, gratitude, and stewardship.

FY 25 GRAND ANNUAL PERFORMANCE

St. Agnes Grand Annual Collection: \$97,922 Grand Annual funds supported projects to preserve our church, enhance safety, and improve the worship environment, including:

- Repairs to the church steeple
- Security enhancements within the church
- Maintenance and repair of the HVAC system
- Construction of a stone walkway around the Blessed Mother Statue

This year, we will continue to focus on much needed repair and maintenance to the church, particularly the hardware on the external Church doors and the flooring in the entry foyer.

St. Camillus Grand Annual Collection: \$82,405 Funds from the Grand Annual were used to support ongoing parish operations and to undertake internal church design and site assessment studies. These studies will help guide future repairs and improvements, including the critical bell tower restoration now planned for the coming year.


CPARL WOMEN'S FALL RETREAT:

providing this meaningful opportunity beyond the classroom. Bravi tutti!






