

I greatly look forward to this season of preparation and expectation every year as we ready our hearts, our minds and our lives for the coming of our Lord.

MEET OUR CHEVERUS AWARDEE: MRS. CAROL GREELEY

Each year on or around the Solemnity of Christ the King, the Archdiocese of Boston awards the Cheverus Medal to lay people, religious and deacons who have made significant contributions to the Church and God's people. The Cheverus Medal is named for Bishop Jean-Louis Anne Lefebvre de Cheverus who was Boston's first Bishop from 1808 until his return to Bordeaux, France in 1824.

This weekend, Carol Greeley of St. Camillus Parish will be awarded the Cheverus Medal by Archbishop Henning at the Cathedral of the Holy Cross in Boston.

Carol was raised in Arlington with sisters Karen and Donna and brother Bobby. She attended St. Agnes School and graduated from Arlington Catholic High School. She and her late husband, Brian have one son, Patrick.

Carol managed ARC Travel, an Arlington family business for many years. She is currently a Senior Real Estate Specialist and Agent with Gibson Sotheby's International Realty in Arlington, Past President of the Arlington Chamber of Commerce, Past President and President-elect of the Rotary Club of Arlington, Executive Secretary of the Arlington Historic District Commissions and coordinates A-SNAP, a monthly program for special needs children.

Carol is involved in many Catholic Parishes of Arlington ministries. She just completed two years as Collaborative Parish Council secretary, coordinates the Catholic Appeal at St. Camillus Parish, is a member of the St. Camillus 75th Anniversary Committee, the Collaborative Social Committee, the Women's Ministry leadership team, and participates in monthly Sancta Maria visits. Carol also recently coordinated the Senior Expo for Arlington residents with 25 vendors and providers of services at St. Camillus Parish.

Her current focus is training her comfort dog, Juliette. She hopes to bring Juliette to visit the residents of Sancta Maria Nursing facility in the near future.


OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST THE KING

In Word & Deed

r. Walter Ciszek, a Jesuit priest being promoted for sainthood, spent years in Russia as a political prisoner. In one of his books, "He Leadeth Me," he writes, "There is a tremendous truth contained in the realization that when God became man, He became a working mannot a king nor chieftain, not a warrior or statesmen, nor a great leader of nations." We celebrate Christ the King, not as a political figure or world leader, but as the King of the Cross where the work of salvation takes place. It is a work of love.

Subjects follow their king into battle. We follow Christ into battle with sin and with death. First, He shows us how to live in love as God intends as He teaches, preaches, heals and forgives. Then, through His death, He destroys the power of sin and evil over us and asks us to pick up the cross and follow Him.


