

Music Notes

Today, we begin singing a new Mass Setting for our worship. The *Mass of the Immaculate Conception* was written by Peter Latona, who is the Director of Music for the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C. On composing this Mass setting, Latona states, "I wanted to create a setting that had a sense of scope and solemnity, something that felt at home in the Roman Catholic Liturgy, something that allowed the text to feel unencumbered; it needed to be singable, efficient, and sound both fresh and familiar. "

In reviewing many of the settings, I find this one to be very easy to follow and learn. It flows musically where you expect. It is powerful in the *Holy, Holy,* and yet prayerful in the *Lamb of God.* This Mass setting can be found in the front of your Missal, beginning on page 49, and the *Holy, Holy* at 50.

In addition to this change, during Advent we are also singing the Communion Antiphon throughout the reception of the Blessed Sacrament. It is found in the order of worship in your missal as well as here on the Worship Notes Page. The antiphon is the congregational response to the verses sung by the cantor or choir.



The Blessing of an Advent Wreath

The use of the Advent Wreath is a traditional practice which has found its place in the Church as well as in the home. The blessing of an Advent Wreath takes place on the First Sunday of Advent or on the evening before the First Sunday of Advent. When the blessing of the Advent Wreath is celebrated in the home, it is appropriate that it be blessed by a parent or another member of the family.

All make the sign of the cross

Leader: Our help is in the name of the Lord. Response (R/.): Who made heaven and earth.


Reader: Let us listen to the words of the Prophet Isaiah (Isaiah 1-2 and 5-6) (Alternately, Isaiah 63 (lines 16-17 & 19) or Isaiah 64 (lines 2-7) may be used).

The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; Upon those who dwelt in the land of gloom a light has shone. You have brought them abundant joy and great rejoicing, As they rejoice before you as at the harvest, as men make merry when dividing spoils. For a child is born to us, a son is given us; upon his shoulder dominion rests. They name him Wonder-Counselor, God-Hero, Father-Forever, Prince of Peace. His dominion is vast and forever peaceful, From David's throne, and over his kingdom, which he confirms and sustains By judgment and justice, both now and forever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will do this!

Reader: The Word of the Lord. R/. Thanks be to God.

Leader:

Lord our God, we praise you for your Son, Jesus Christ: he is Emmanuel, the hope of the peoples, he is the wisdom that teaches and guides us, he is the Savior of every nation. Lord God, let your blessing come upon us as we light the candles of this wreath. May the wreath and its light



be a sign of Christ's promise to bring us salvation.

May he come quickly and not delay. We ask this through Christ our Lord. R/. Amen.

The blessing may conclude with a verse from "O Come, O Come, Emmanuel":

O come, desire of nations, bind in one the hearts of humankind: bid ev'ry sad division cease and be thyself our Prince of peace. Rejoice! Rejoice! Emmanuel shall come to thee, O Israel.
