

STAFF REFLECTION

On the Fourth Sunday of Advent, Matthew's Gospel invites us to see the mystery of Jesus' birth through Joseph's eyes. Joseph is often quiet in Scripture, but for those devoted to him, his silence speaks of deep faith, courage, and trust in God.

Joseph and Mary are betrothed, already bound by covenant. When Mary is found to be with child, Joseph faces a painful dilemma. By law, he could expose her, but instead, he chooses mercy, planning to pro-



tect her from shame. In this moment of uncertainty, God sends an angel in a dream. The angel reveals that the child is conceived by the Holy Spirit, that his name will be Jesus - "God saves" - and that he fulfills Isaiah's prophecy: Emmanuel, "God with us."

Joseph listens. He obeys. He takes Mary as his wife and accepts the child as his own. This moment is a powerful reminder of his role as guardian of the Holy Family and protector of the Church. His quiet strength, his willingness to trust God's plan even when it was difficult, makes him a model of fatherhood, humility, and faith.

For me, devotion to St. Joseph is deeply personal. On our honeymoon, my wife and I visited the great St. Joseph Oratory in Montreal, Canada. There, moved by St. Joseph's example and presence, we asked him to be our patron saint. That moment of entrusting ourselves to Joseph has shaped how I read this Gospel passage: Joseph is not only a figure of the past, but a living intercessor who continues to guide and protect those who turn to him.

Joseph shows us that holiness is often lived in hidden ways - through obedience, mercy, and courage. For those who pray to him, he is a steadfast companion, teaching us to trust God's will and to care for others with love. Alongside Mary, Joseph is a shining example of what it means to be a faithful servant of the Lord, and for those who claim him as patron, he is a constant reminder that God is with us.






