

## CHALKING OF THE DOOR

Bless your door on the feast of the Epiphany!

The chalking of the doors is a centuries-old practice throughout the world. It is used to bless your home and all who enter for the coming year.

Use chalk to write on the outside, inside, or above the main front entrance, the first two numbers of the year + C + M + B + the last two numbers of the year.



Tradition tells us that the letters stand for the names of the magi: Caspar, Malchior, Bethasar; but it is also an abbreviation for "Christus Mansionem Benedicat" which means, "May Christ bless this dwelling!" It is appropriate to bless your door in January – *janua* means "door" and the first month is the door to the new year.

After inscribing the doorway, say this prayer:

*Lord God of heaven and earth Bless this hour and all who live here and all who visit May we fill this place With kindness to one another, With hospitality to guests, And with abundant care, For every stranger By the gentle light of a star. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.*

You may conclude with Christmas carols such as "We Three Kings."





## SOLEMNITY OF THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

“All of creation is changed by the appearance of Christ.”

In popular tradition, the feast of Epiphany commemorates the arrival of the three kings at the stable in Bethlehem where Christ was born. The gospel reading for the day—Matthew 2:1-12—tells the story. Over the years, a lot of tradition has grown around this story. Many people will tell you that the magi were three kings, named Caspar, Balthazar, and Melchior, and they may note that Caspar is traditionally depicted with darker skin. But if you read those twelve short verses from Matthew’s Gospel, it becomes clear that we really know very little about the magi. We don’t know their names. We don’t know where they came from—Matthew only says “from the east.” We don’t even know that they were kings. The word used by Matthew is “magi,” meaning someone learned in esoteric knowledge. Some translations call them “astrologers,” but the only basis for that is the statement that they were following a star. And even the star itself is a mystery. Astronomers can chart the movement of the stars back in time, but they can’t seem to agree about the existence of an astronomical event that would explain the reference. And even the most casual observer would have a hard time explaining what it would mean for a star to move through the sky and then stop over a particular place. Regardless of who the magi were and how the star showed them the way, the most significant

part of this event is the identity of the one who is made known—Jesus, the newborn king, who is worthy of homage by all men and women. The meaning of the epiphany that occurs in this gospel passage is that the “the newborn king of the Jews” is revealed to and recognized by people from far and distant lands. The appearance of mystical signs in the sky makes the point that all of creation is changed by the appearance of Christ. Because God has chosen to become human, all creation and all the people of the earth can experience the redemption he has come to bring.



## JANUARY 4TH: ST. ELIZABETH ANN SETON

St. Elizabeth Ann Seton (1774–1821) was the first native-born United States citizen to be canonized. She founded the first Catholic girls' school in the country and later established the Sisters of Charity, the first American-based religious community for women. St. Elizabeth Ann Seton is credited with helping lay the foundation for the Catholic school system in the United States.




## JANUARY 11TH: THE FEAST OF THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

St. Timothy and St. Titus were close contemporaries of Saint Paul the Apostle. St. Timothy served as a bishop in Ephesus, and St. Titus as a bishop in Crete. Their work helped to lead and strengthen the early Christian communities. Both are addressed in the New Testament in letters written by St. Paul which offer guidance on faith, leadership, and perseverance.

## JANUARY 27TH: ST. ANGELA MERCI

Saint Angela Merici (1474–1540) was an Italian saint and founder of the Company of Saint Ursula (Ursulines), dedicated to the Christian education of girls. Orphaned at a young age, she lived a life of prayer, service, and spiritual guidance. Known for her wisdom and complete trust in God, her legacy continues through Ursuline communities throughout the world.

## JANUARY 28TH: ST. THOMAS AQUINAS

St. Thomas Aquinas (1225–1274) was a Dominican friar, priest, and theologian, widely regarded as one of the greatest thinkers in the Catholic tradition. He is famous for combining Christian teaching with Aristotle's philosophy, showing how faith and reason work together. His writings, especially the *Summa Theologiae*, continue to shape Catholic teaching, philosophy, and education today.


