

Following this morning's deadly shooting in Minneapolis, I reiterate my plea for all people of good will to join me in prayer for the person who was killed, for their loved ones, and for our community.

We continue to be at a time in this country when we need to lower the temperature of rhetoric, stop fear-filled speculation and start seeing all people as created in the image and likeness of God. That is as true for our immigrant sisters and brothers as it is for our elected officials and those who are responsible for enforcing our laws. I echo today the repeated call of the U.S. Catholic bishops that we come together as a nation and pass meaningful immigration reform that does justice to all parties. The longer we refuse to grapple with this issue in the political arena, the more divisive and violent it becomes.

It is only by working together – with God's help – that we will have peace in our communities, state and world.

## INVOCATION FOR PEACE WORDS OF POPE FRANCIS JUNE 8TH, 2014

Lord, God of Abraham, God of the Prophets, God of Love, you created us and you call us to live as brothers and sisters. Give us the strength daily to be instruments of peace; enable us to see everyone who crosses our path as our brother or sister. Make us sensitive to the plea of our citizens who entreat us to turn our weapons of war into implements of peace, our trepidation into confident trust, and our quarreling into forgiveness.

Keep alive within us the flame of hope, so that with patience and perseverance we may opt for dialogue and reconciliation. In this way may peace triumph at last, and may the words "division", "hatred" and "war" be banished from the heart of every man and woman. Lord, defuse the violence of our tongues and our hands. Renew our hearts and minds, so that the word which always brings us together will be "brother", and our way of life will always be that of: Shalom, Peace, Salaam!





# FEAST OF ST. AGNES



Wednesday, January 21st is the Feast of St. Agnes of Rome, Virgin and Martyr.

## ABOUT SAINT AGNES

According to legend, Saint Agnes was a beautiful girl, the daughter of a Roman noble. She was raised as a Christian and consecrated herself to Christ through a vow of chastity. During Emperor Diocletian's reign, Saint Agnes became a martyr at the age of 12 or 13 for refusing to marry the prefect's son. As the legend continues, when some men tried to take advantage of young Agnes, her hair grew, thereby covering her up and protecting her virginity. She was reported to the authorities for being Christian, was arrested and sentenced to death by burning. Tradition says that the flames did not consume Saint Agnes, so she was beheaded. She was buried in a catacomb near Rome, where Constantine's daughter built a basilica in her honor. She is depicted in art as a young girl in robes, holding a palm branch in her hands with a lamb at her feet or in her arms as a symbol of purity.

## DID YOU KNOW?

Saint Agnes's name is taken from the Latin *agnus*, or, "lamb," which connotes gentleness, purity, and submission. Each year on her feast day, two lambs are brought to the pope to be blessed. The wool from these lambs is woven into the palliums (bands of white wool), which the pope gives to newly consecrated Archbishops. In St. Agnes Upper Church, there is a first class relic of a fragment of St. Agnes's bone. This is displayed in the monstrance in front of her statue to the left of the Marian altar (see photo below).


## NATIONAL LATIN EXAM GLOBAL RANKINGS



For the second year in a row, Saint Agnes School/Arlington Catholic High School Latin students ranked second in Massachusetts, New England, the U.S., and the world on the National Latin Exam, earning 25 Perfect Scores in 2025. Students also received 53 Gold Medals and

6 Silver Medals – a remarkable achievement reflecting academic excellence and dedication by our students and their instructor, Dr. Daniel B. McGlathery.




