LET THE BELLS RING AGAIN!

BELLS AND TOWER . . . The three bells which will hang in the belfry of St. Camillus Church, Arlington, stand before Bishop Thomas J. Riley and other dignitaries who will participate in the ceremonies of consecration. The small bell is

known as the Gesu Bambino, the middle bell as the Ave Maria and the large one as the St. Joseph Bell. The bell consecration at St. Camillus is thought to be the first such ceremony in this archdiocese for over 70 years.

Structural damage to our bell tower has kept the St. Camillus chimes silent for the past year. The engineering assessment revealed severe deterioration, and continued vibration from the bells could compromise the tower's long-term stability.

Your generous gift will help repair our bell tower so that our bells may once again ring out across our town, proclaiming faith, hope, and love for generations to come.

Let us fill the air with the sound of faith once more!

ST. CAMILLUS' BELLS, A HISTORICAL LANDMARK

The St. Camillus Chimes consist of 14 beautifully crafted bells cast by Royal Bellfounders Petit & Fritsen of Aarle-Rixtel, Netherlands, one of the world's oldest family-owned bell foundries (est. 1660), famed for casting bells from traditional tintinnabulous bell metal for use in towers, chimes, and grand carillons worldwide.

The Chime was installed in 1966, and today, it is one of only eight in Massachusetts with more than 14 bells, making it a rare and treasured instrument.







WINTER PROGRAMS - LIMITED OPENINGS

Tot Sports Academy – Preschoolers between the ages of 3-5 years old will be introduced to the basics of sports in a fun way. The program is offered from 12:30 PM - 1:15 PM on Tuesdays and/or Thursdays in the little gym (main building).

- **Multi Sport & Games- Tuesdays.** Participants will be introduced to sports & games in a safe environment. Runs through February 10th.
- **Soccer- Thursdays.** The sport of soccer will be introduced in a fun atmosphere. Drills and games will be tailored for the preschool age. Runs through February 12th.

Gaga Ball – This fast-paced kinder variation of dodgeball is played in an octagonal pit. Offered Tuesdays from 3:15 PM – 4:00 PM for K-2nd graders, and 4:00 PM - 4:45 PM for 3rd-6th grades. The program runs until February 10th.

Pillo Polo/Hockey – Pillo Polo has all the ingredients of floor hockey, but uses a lightweight Pillo Polo stick which features a foam head on the end for accurate contact with the ball. The program is offered on Wednesdays from 3:15 PM – 4:00 PM for grades K-1, and from 4:00 PM – 4:45 PM for grades 2-6. Runs through February 11th.

Polar Bear Football – Flag Football games played for grades 2 -6 on Fridays from 3:15 PM – 4:00 PM. This is an outdoor activity which runs through February 13th.




