

BOSTON SOCK EXCHANGE

In our 15th year of service to our unhoused brothers and sisters, the Boston Sock Exchange has been a continuous ministry since 2011. Once a month, parishioners gather at the St. Camillus kitchen to prepare 100 bagged lunches for the unhoused in the Boston area. We currently deliver these lunches to the Bristol Lodge Soup Kitchen in Waltham, which serves dinner daily. Guests receive one of our lunch bags as they leave for the following day. Each bag contains a sandwich, fruit, a granola bar, water, and a pair of socks. We also provide small toiletries and seasonal items such as hats, scarves, and gloves.

All of this is made possible by the generosity of our parishioners, who continue to supply the necessary ingredients and items. **THANK YOU** for your continued support over the years; this ministry would not be possible without you. **Our next gathering is on Monday, February 19th at 6:30 PM in the St. Camillus kitchen.**





“We too are called to welcome Jesus who comes to meet us. To encounter him: the God of life is to be encountered every day of our lives; not now and then, but every day. To follow Jesus is not a decision taken once and for all, it is a daily choice.” —Pope Francis, Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, 2019

The Presentation of Jesus in the temple shows him to be the firstborn Son who belongs to the Lord. With Simeon and Anna, all Israel awaits its encounter with the Savior—the name given to this event in the Byzantine tradition. Jesus is recognized as the long-expected Messiah, the “light of the nations” and the “glory of Israel,” but also “a sign that is spoken against.” The sword of sorrow predicted for Mary announces Christ’s perfect and unique oblation on the cross that will impart the salvation of God has “prepared in the presence of all peoples” (CCC, no. 529).

World Day for Consecrated Life


In 1997, Pope Saint John Paul II instituted a day of prayer for women and men in consecrated life. This celebration is attached to the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord on February 2nd. This Feast is also known as Candlemas Day; the day on which candles are blessed symbolizing Christ who is the light of the world. So too, those in consecrated life are called to reflect the light of Jesus Christ to all peoples. The celebration of World Day for Consecrated Life is transferred to the following Sunday in order to highlight the gift of consecrated persons for the whole Church. Please pray for all those who have made commitments in the consecrated life and be sure to thank them on their special day. May they continue to be inspired by Jesus Christ and respond generously to God’s gift of their vocation.





WINTER PROGRAMS - LIMITED OPENINGS

Tot Sports Academy – Preschoolers between the ages of 3-5 years old will be introduced to the basics of sports in a fun way. The program is offered from 12:30 PM - 1:15 PM on Tuesdays and/or Thursdays in the little gym (main building).

- **Multi Sport & Games- Tuesdays.** Participants will be introduced to sports & games in a safe environment. Runs through February 10th.
- **Soccer- Thursdays.** The sport of soccer will be introduced in a fun atmosphere. Drills and games will be tailored for the preschool age. Runs through February 12th.

Gaga Ball – This fast-paced kinder variation of dodgeball is played in an octagonal pit. Offered Tuesdays from 3:15 PM – 4:00 PM for K-2nd graders, and 4:00 PM - 4:45 PM for 3rd-6th grades. The program runs until February 10th.

Pillo Polo/Hockey – Pillo Polo has all the ingredients of floor hockey, but uses a lightweight Pillo Polo stick which features a foam head on the end for accurate contact with the ball. The program is offered on Wednesdays from 3:15 PM – 4:00 PM for grades K-1, and from 4:00 PM – 4:45 PM for grades 2-6. Runs through February 11th.

Polar Bear Football – Flag Football games played for grades 2 -6 on Fridays from 3:15 PM – 4:00 PM. This is an outdoor activity which runs through February 13th.

Ping Pong Club- Learn and improve ping pong skills while having fun and playing in tournaments. The program is offered on Mondays from 3:15 PM – 4:00 PM for grades 3-6. Runs until February 9th.

Gymnastics – Limited openings available in our established Gymnastics program which combines tumbling, balance, conditioning, flexibility & fun! Winter classes continue through March 9th. Flyers describing the program in detail are available.

Billiards/Pool Club- This program is designed to introduce youth to the game of billiards (often referred to as pool), providing them with a fun environment to learn basic skills, practice shots, and participate in friendly competition. Offered on Wednesdays from 1:45 PM – 2:00 PM for grades 2-6. Runs until February 11th.




