Dear Faith Family,

This Lent, as I mentioned to some on Ash Wednesday, I have chosen to walk Lent with a friend. That friend is Blessed Father Stanley Francis Rother. Fr. Stanley was martyred in Guatemala, in 1981. His story is well

told by his biographer, Maria Ruiz Scaperlanda, and by the book reflecting on his life in Guatemala written by Fr. Henri Nouwen. Fr. Nouwen reflects on Fr. Stanley's life of service and his death into new life.

I will attempt to share some of my thoughts while walking with Fr. Stanley this Lent. Below is my first insight, if it can be called that.

In January 1981, Fr. Stanley returned to Oklahoma and was greeted by his parents at the airport. There is a picture of his mother embracing and kissing him while his father looks on. When you see the picture, you can feel the relief that Mrs. Rother has from her son's homecoming.

I was reminded of my homecoming in 2006, from my tour in Iraq with the Marines. I was greeted by my father and sister at Fort Devens. Relief and stress were evident on their faces.

What I learned was that my choice to follow Christ, as a priest – has consequences for those who support and love me. I can see the goodness in the struggles that may be obscured for them.

Fr. Stanley returned to Guatemala, in April of 1981. His "folks" would have to say goodbye to him again. The fruits of faithful service can be hard to accept and understand. They would not be able to welcome him back to Oklahoma with the same joy, as that summer, he was killed.

I hope to share more of my learnings from Fr. Stanley in the weeks to come.

GUIDELINES FOR THE RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

As the communicant in front of you receives Holy Communion, you are to make a sign of reverence. The Bishops of the United States have decided that this sign of reverence is to be a bow. You then approach the Priest, Deacon, or Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion (hereinafter Priest) with hands extended. The Priest then lifts the Sacred Host, shows it to the communicant, and says, "The Body of Christ." The communicant says, "Amen." If one receives on the tongue, the communicant approaches the Priest who lifts the Host and shows it to the communicant and says, "The Body of Christ." The communicant then says, "Amen," opens his/her mouth, and extends his/her tongue (Please be sure to hold still until after the Host is placed on your tongue!).

It is permissible in the United States to receive on the tongue or in the hand. One should never take Communion. Communion should always be received. The emphasis should be on reverent reception. **It is crucial that the Host should be consumed immediately upon reception.** (Do not walk away with the host in your hand.)

There is nothing intrinsically more reverent about reception on the tongue or less reverent about receiving in the hand. Reverence or irreverence are generally determined by other factors: the spiritual attitude of the recipient, the demeanor of the one giving communion, the adequacy of Eucharistic understanding, and the manner in which the Eucharistic elements are treated both within and outside Mass. St. Cyril of Jerusalem in the fourth century offered a beautiful and powerful catechesis on the mode of receiving communion in the hand that is still applicable today:

"When you approach, do not go stretching out your open hands or having your fingers spread out, but make the left hand into a throne for the right which shall receive the King, and then cup your open hand and the Body of Christ, reciting the 'Amen.' Then sanctify with all care your eyes by touching the Sacred Body, and receive it. But be careful that no particles fall, for what you lose would be to you as if you had lost some of your members. Tell me, if anybody had given you gold dust, would you not hold fast to it with all care, and watch lest some of it fall and be lost to you? Must you not then be even more careful with that which is more precious than gold and diamonds, so that no particles are lost?"

LENT IS A TIME FOR REFLECTION, REPENTANCE AND RESTORATION.

Examination of Conscience

In the Catholic spiritual tradition, we have a method of self-evaluation that might be a valuable spiritual exercise at this time of year. It's called an "examination of conscience." Although there are lots of different forms of this exercise, all of them are comprised of a structured list of questions to ask yourself, designed to help you determine where you might have gone wrong, what your spiritual weaknesses are, and even what you should have done that maybe you neglected to do.

If you've never done a formal examination of conscience, this might seem like a big downer. But this is a list that's just between you and God. There's no need to sugarcoat it. If, after going through the exercise, you've discovered some serious issues needing reconciliation and forgiveness, then you're well prepared for the Sacrament of Reconciliation or confession. At a minimum, you'll be able to base your Lenten sacrifice on something concrete.

A Brief Examination of Conscience Based on the Ten Commandments

I am the Lord your God: you shall not have strange Gods before me.

Have I treated people, events, or things as more important than God?

You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.

Have my words, actively or passively, put down God, the Church, or people?

Remember to keep holy the Lord's Day.

Do I go to Mass every Sunday (or Saturday Vigil) and on Holy Days of Obligation? Do I avoid, when possible, work that impedes worship to God, joy for the Lord's Day, and proper relaxation of mind and body? Do I look for ways to spend

time with family or in service on Sunday?

Honor your father and your mother.

Do I show my parents due respect? Do I seek to maintain good communication with my parents where possible? Do I criticize them for lacking skills I think they should have?

You shall not kill.

Have I harmed another through physical, verbal, or emotional means, including gossip or manipulation of any kind?

You shall not commit adultery.

Have I respected the physical and sexual dignity of others and of myself?

You shall not steal.

Have I taken or wasted time or resources that belonged to another?

You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.

Have I gossiped, told lies, or embellished stories at the expense of another?

You shall not covet your neighbor's spouse.

Have I honored my spouse with my full affection and exclusive love?

You shall not covet your neighbor's goods.

Am I content with my own means and needs, or do I compare myself to others unnecessarily?



Act of Contrition

My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Savior Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In his name, my God, have mercy.

Jesus offers forgiveness to us through the Sacrament of Reconciliation. As Catholics, we are called to experience Reconciliation at least once a year. Journey through Lent with a clean heart and an open mind.






