Dear Faith Family,

I am deliberately journeying this Lent with Blessed (Fr.) Stanley Francis Rother. It is a conversation that is informed by other friends. As I reflect upon Stanley's life, I was reminded of a

story St. John Bosco (1815 – 1888) shared about his young friend St. Dominic Savio (1842 – 1857):

*On one occasion, two boys had gotten into an argument and challenged each other to a rock duel. This was a common way young thugs and street gangs settled arguments. These duels usually ended with someone getting hurt and sometimes seriously. It seems that one boy had insulted the other's family. The two boys became so enraged that the only way they could think of settling the affair was to fight with stones. They were to meet in the lot about ten minutes' walk from the Oratory.*

*Dominic Savio learned about the fight. He caught up with the boys and tried to talk them out of it. They would not hear of it. Dominic followed them to a field where the fight was to take place.*

*Dominic pleaded, "You must stop this. It is not right!"*

*One of the boys shouted, "You can't stop us."*

*"Not until I split his head open..." the other added.*

*"I am not stopping the fight," shot back Dominic, "but I am asking you to accept one condition."*

*"And what's that?" They asked.*

*By now they had arrived at the field to set up the duel. Each boy stood facing the other with a distance of about twenty feet between them. Each had a pile of stones arranged at his feet. On the signal, they would begin to throw the stones at each other until one gave up or was seriously injured.*

*Dominic stepped between them. One of the two shouted, "Dominic, what are you doing?"*

*"Do you promise you will fight under the condition I will set up?"*

*"Yes, now get out of the way, agreed one of the boys."*

*The other shouted, "Let's get this over with. What's the condition?"*

*Taking out a small crucifix, which he used to wear around his neck, Dominic held it up.*

*"Before you start the fight you must look at this crucifix and throw the first stone at me."*

*He strode before the angrier boy, and kneeling down said, "You start! Throw the first stone at me!"*

*Taken by surprise, the boy began to tremble. "No!" He protested. "Never! I have no argument with you, Dominic."*

*Dominic ran over to the other boy. He too was astonished and assured Dominic he was his friend and meant him no harm.*

*Then Dominic stood up. Looking at them, he said with great emotion: "Neither of you is ready to hurt me because I am your friend, yet you want to commit this sin over a stupid remark made at school. Christ, who was innocent, died for us rather than seek revenge from those who hated him." Dominic stood, silent, crucifix in hand. Both boys dropped their stones, ashamed before his courageous stand.*

*"At that moment," one of them later admitted, "all my determination broke down, and a cold chill ran through me. I hated myself for having forced a good friend like Dominic to go to such lengths to keep us from sin. To show my regret, I forgave the boy who had insulted me and asked Dominic to tell me of some good priest who would hear my confession" (<https://donboscowest.org/dominic-savio>). (Edited for clarity.)*

Blessed Stanley certainly found himself standing in the middle of two angry factions: the Guatemalan government and the communists. He stood in the middle with the native people of his parish who were suffering due to the conflict. It was the native people who were lacking basic medical care, public safety, and respect for their human dignity. Stanley was not a political agent. He was a shepherd feeding the poor and caring for widows and children. This was seen as threatening to the forces he was caught between.

The Church must be concerned about the people involved, not merely about who is correct. The role of the Church is to stand in the middle, to be willing to be hurt, and to seek reconciliation where others do not think it is possible.

## LITURGICAL MUSINGS

This is a new column for the CPARL bulletin. This column will address liturgical practices of the Collaborative. It will attempt to answer questions that parishioners have, in a generalized manner. If you have a question, send them to [info@cparl.org](mailto:info@cparl.org) and you may find the answer in an upcoming bulletin.

For instance, you may have noticed that the ushers and greeters have modified their practice at communion time. They no longer direct the exit of the pews. There is no great theological reason. It is a practice that was necessary during our COVID period to comply with Archdiocesan and Board of Health guidelines, and that necessity has ended.

The ushers/greeters will be positioned at the heads of the side aisles. This is done for two purposes. Primarily, they are there to assist any person that has physical challenges and would like some support. Secondly, they are there to remind people to consume the Blessed Sacrament prior to leaving the minister. They may gently remind a person to consume. If the person does not consume, they are to inform the presider or the deacon.

Unfortunately, there have been increased reports of people exiting the churches with the Blessed Sacrament for nefarious reasons. We have a duty to ensure the reverent reception of the Eucharist.

We hope that this new column is helpful as we grow as a community of worship.

## SAINT OF THE MONTH March



## ST. JOSEPH WAS A HOLY MAN – AND A VERY GOOD FATHER

**Feast Day:** March 19, transferred to March 20 when the 19th is a Sunday.

St. Joseph is the patron of all families, especially of fathers, and the patron and protector of our family in faith, the Church.

The Scriptures don't say much about St. Joseph, but we can figure out what kind of man he was just from the little we read. He came from the royal line of King David, but was a man of modest means who could only afford the temple sacrifice of two doves when Jesus was circumcised. He was a man who loved and trusted God, listening to the messages of angels and trusting in their messages. He was a man of courage, following God's plan for him though it was contrary to societal norms of the time. He was a man of action, doing whatever he needed to do to protect his family from danger. He made sure that Jesus was brought up in the practice of his faith, making the annual trek to Jerusalem for Passover. He was a good and loving father, worried sick about Jesus when he disappeared during one of the Passover trips.

St. Joseph is a wonderful model for fathers today. He teaches us to love and trust God, in choosing to follow God's plan over what might have been his own. He teaches us to love our spouses – one of the most important gifts we can give our children. Joseph put Mary's needs before his own, sacrificing his reputation to protect hers and supporting her choice to follow God's plan for her life. He teaches us to love our children, embracing the infant Jesus as his own son, humbly and quietly providing care, guidance and protection for him as he grows.

We read nothing more about Joseph after his family is reunited during that frightening visit to Jerusalem. Because Jesus entrusts Mary to one of his disciples at his crucifixion, we can make the assumption that Joseph died before Jesus fulfilled his mission on earth. For generations, Catholics have painted a picture of Joseph breathing his last with Mary and Jesus by his side to comfort him.






