THE NATURE & ROLE OF PARISH COUNCILS

Recently, our Collaborative Pastoral Council attended presentation by Archbishop Henning focused around the work and responsibilities of a parish council. He provided many insights about his work in the Archdiocese, as well. Thank you to CPC member Liz Harrison for this wonderful summary (slightly shortened for editorial purposes).

Mission:

1. With God at the center of our mission, the evening began with evening prayer with voices raised in prayer and song. Archbishop reminded us that all things come from God and that we are to trust in his guidance. The Holy Spirit was invited in to join us.

2. We were reminded that we work in collaboration with the pastor. We are a consulting body offering our time and talents to the parish. Each parish has two councils; a pastoral council and a finance council. In simplified terms, one dreams and the other decides if we can afford those dreams and how to pay for them. The two are essential and need to work together. Their existence within a parish is mandated by canon law.

3. We work together to arrive at decisions. If conflict arises, we do our best to collaborate and come to consensus. However, the pastor ultimately decides – not majority. The story of a mature married couple who lead pre-cana classes was offered as an example of how to argue respectfully – when they argue their rule is they need to hold hands. The image was referred to throughout the evening and offered a lighthearted image of what we should strive for.

4. We were reminded that we are not a club, we are a community. We seek diversity of opinions and need to remember this is God’s work. Resist the urge to micromanage, leave room for creativity. Take joy in the honor of participating and contributing in this important job.

State of Archdiocese:

5. There is a revival underway not only in the Boston archdiocese, but across the nation. Young people are leading this revival. They are looking for more than life with screens. Bible studies are popping up at many universities, not just Catholic universities.

NB: We need to be able to welcome in this young and energetic cohort as they move on from their school communities and before they look for fulfillment somewhere other than the Catholic Church. With limited resources we need to be creative.

6. There is a rise in vocations to priesthood. With potentially 20 young men currently entering formation, there is the potential for growth going forward, though it is all in God’s hands.

7. Archbishop Henning was extremely sensitive to the deep wounds still present in the Boston Diocese due to the clergy sexual abuse scandal. He detected both confusion and shame in being a Catholic in Boston. He knows he needs to address this confusion. He wants to be a teacher of the faith. We should be ashamed of sin, but never be ashamed of who we are.

8. Real Estate: There are many beautiful old church buildings in the Archdiocese of Boston. Are these treasures a gift or a burden? The Archbishop instituted a 1-year moratorium on any selling of church properties upon entering the Boston Archdiocese in order to be able to introduce a necessary pause. More thinking, planning and analyzing was needed at the decision phase of the project (the “should we do this”), before any contracts were signed. There is a current backlog of projects, but movement is happening again

9. Commitment to community. The strength of Boston’s communities is also a weakness if it leads to being too parochial. We need to remember that each parish is part of the larger diocese, and we are all on the same team. There is amazing diversity within the diocese with 25 languages across the diocese. We need to be sensitive to the anxiety within the immigrant communities.

Going forward:

10. Archbishop Henning will keep visiting parishes but is planning to slow the pace. He wants to understand at a deeper level the policies and procedures of the parishes, how to communicate better with them, and do a financial study. For the study he is planning to use an outside consulting firm. The question is, should there be an Archdiocesan campaign to raise funds?

11. The Archbishop reminded us that he is a pastor, not a politician. He sees his job as a) teaching, b) governing and c) sanctifying. He avoids speaking about politics and tries to stick to the three ideas above.

12. He wants his message to get out to the lay faithful and would like to be able to communicate through parish bulletins.

Final thoughts: In preparing for the revival remember: People are limited, God is not. What do parish priests need: Most important is prayer and practical support. Maybe a home cooked meal!



LITURGICAL MUSINGS

With the arrival of the Fifth Sunday of Lent, we begin to turn our hearts and minds toward the imminent Passion, Death and – ultimately – Resurrection of Christ.

A significant change that begins on the Fifth Sunday of Lent is the traditional veiling of the statues, icons, or other images throughout the Church. This stark change in our worship space serves as a visual cue to prepare us for the holiest days of the Church’s year.

The Roman Missal instructs: *“In the Dioceses of the United States, the practice of covering crosses and images throughout the church from [the fifth] Sunday [of Lent] may be observed. Crosses remain covered until the end of the Celebration of the Lord’s Passion on Good Friday, but images remain covered until the beginning of the Easter Vigil.”*

How did this tradition begin? The veiling of the statues is thought to stem from a medieval German tradition in which altars were covered for the entirety of Lent with a large cloth covering known as a “fasting” or “hunger cloth.” Their purpose was twofold: to intensify the sense of longing and penitence during Lent, and to focus the faithful more deeply on prayer and repentance rather than on visual beauty.

Over time, this custom developed into the more familiar practice of veiling individual crosses and images during the final weeks of Lent. The temporary absence of these sacred images increases our anticipation for their return. When the crucifix is unveiled on Good Friday and the images reappear at the Easter Vigil, the Church’s beauty is restored in a powerful sign of the joy of the Resurrection.

HE MADE HIS DWELLING AMONG US

The Annunciation and the Gospel of Life

The Annunciation celebrates the visit of the angel Gabriel to the Virgin Mary to inform her that she was to be the mother of Jesus. On this great feast day, we not only recall Mary's courageous "yes" to God, we also celebrate the Incarnation of Christ, our Savior. For it was there, in the womb of a woman, nine months before the celebration of the manger, that "the Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us" (John 1:14).

The celebration of the Annunciation coincides with the anniversary of the papal encyclical *Evangelium vitae* (*The Gospel of Life*). This prophetic document on the dignity and inviolability of every human life was put forth by Pope John Paul II on the Solemnity of the Annunciation in 1995. The intimate connection of these two events highlights a profound reality about the identity and value of every human person.

Luke's Gospel tells us that by the power of the Holy Spirit, Christ would be conceived within the womb of Mary. It was there, in the womb of the Blessed Mother, that Christ first took on human flesh and made his dwelling among us. Like us, the unborn child Jesus grew and developed beneath the shelter of his mother's loving heart. Through Christ's Incarnation, God chose to share fully and intimately in our humanity and bridge all distance between God and man, so that we may dwell together.

The Church teaches us that "by His incarnation the Son of God has united Himself in some fashion with every man."¹ God desired to dwell among us, as one of us, in order to bring us salvation. This truth "reveals to humanity not only the boundless love of God... but also the incomparable value of every human person."²

Each of us is made in the image and likeness of our Creator, to share in the very life of God himself. This reality "reveals the greatness and the inestimable value of human life."³ The human person is "a manifestation of God in the world, a sign of his presence, a trace of his glory."⁴ Created through the love of the Father, each one of us bears "an indelible imprint of God."⁵ By sharing in our humanity, Christ invites us to share in his divinity, that we might dwell with him for eternity.

Therefore, "the Gospel of God's love for man, the Gospel of the dignity of the person and the Gospel of life are a single and indivisible Gospel."⁶ Through Christ's descent to earth God desires to raise each one of us to the heights of heaven. May we recognize that to proclaim the Gospel of Life is to proclaim Christ, the one who *made his dwelling among us*.
