ITINERARY

Day 1 – June 5: Depart U.S.A.

Our pilgrimage begins today as we depart on our overnight flight to Israel. Meals and drinks served aloft.

Day 2 – June 6: Arrive Tel Aviv / Jerusalem After arrival at Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv we will be met by our local guide who will accompany us through our pilgrimage and make the scripture come alive as we follow in the footsteps of Jesus. Drive to our hotel in Jerusalem. Mass at hotel upon arrival. (D)

Day 3 – June 7: Jerusalem

This morning we will drive to Beit Sahur where we will celebrate Mass at the Shepherd's Field. We will then proceed a short distance to Bethlehem where we will visit the Nativity Church which was built by the Emperor Constantine in the 4th century above the traditional Grotto of Jesus' birth. Also tour the Manger, the Grotto of St. Jerome, the Church of St. Catherine and the Franciscan Family Center. (B/D)

Day 4 – June 8: Jerusalem

This morning we will view the Temple Area of the Old City of Jerusalem featuring the Dome of the Rock, el Aqsa Mosque and the Wailing Wall. Next proceed to Mt. Zion and celebrate Mass at the Franciscan Chapel adjacent to the Cenacle. Then visit the Upper Room where Jesus celebrated the Last Supper, Dormition Abbey where Mary fell into eternal sleep, and St. Peter in Gallicantu where Peter denied Jesus three times. In the afternoon we will proceed to the Israel Museum in the New City of Jerusalem where we will see a scale model of Jerusalem as it appeared 2,000 years ago and the Shrine of the Book which houses the Dead Sea Scrolls. (B/D)



Day 5 – June 9: Jerusalem

This morning we visit the Church of St. Anne where the Blessed Virgin Mary was born, the Pool of Bethesda where Jesus healed the paralytic man and where we will have a Anointing Service, the Chapel of Flagellation, Lithostrotos, and Arch of the "Ecce Homo". Then follow the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher to visit Golgotha and the Tomb of the Risen Savior. In the afternoon we will drive to Ein Karem to celebrate Mass at the Visitation Church where Mary proclaimed her famous "Magnificat" and the Church of St. John the Baptist where St. John the Baptist was born. (B/D)

Day 6 – June 10: Jerusalem

This morning we will drive to the top of the Mt. of Olives for a spectacular view of Jerusalem. Visit the Church of Pater Noster where Jesus taught the Lord's prayer to his Disciples and the Chapel of Ascension where Jesus ascended into Heaven forty days after his resurrection. Then walk along the "Palm Sunday Road" to Dominus Flevit where Our Lord wept over Jerusalem. Continue to the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations for Mass on the Rock of Agony. (B/D)

Day 7 - June 11: Jerusalem

After an early Mass at the Church of the Holy Sepulcher we will return to our hotel for breakfast. Following breakfast, proceed to Bethany to visit the site of the home of Mary, Martha & Lazarus and the Tomb of Lazarus. We will then continue through the Judean Wilderness and pass through Jericho, the oldest known city in the Western world, where we will view from our coach the ancient "tel", Elisha's Fountain, the Qarantal and the Mount of Temptation. Then proceed to Qumran to see the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Afterwards we will have an opportunity to take a dip in the salty, mineral laden waters of the Dead Sea before returning to Jerusalem. (B/D)

Day 8 – June 12: Jerusalem / Tiberias
Depart Jerusalem and drive to the traditional Baptismal
Site on the Jordan River known as Qasr el Yahud where
we will have an opportunity to renew our baptismal
vows. We will then drive north through the Jordan
Valley to Bet Shean where we'll explore the extraordinary excavations of an ancient Roman city.

Continue on to the Sea of Galilee and proceed to Magdala, the hometown of Mary Magdalene, where we will celebrate Mass an visit an ancient synagogue where experts say Jesus may well have taught. Then drive a short distance to Tiberias for check-in at our hotel located on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. (B/D)

Day 9 – June 13: Tiberias

This morning we will enjoy a scenic boat ride across the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum, home of Our Lord during his ministry. After visiting the synagogue where He taught, proceed to Tabgha, site of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes, and to the nearby Church of the Primacy of Peter. Then drive up to the Mt. of the Beatitudes for Mass at the site of the Sermon on the Mount. (B/L/D)

Day 10 – June 14: Tiberias

Following breakfast, we will drive to Cana of Galilee, where Our Lord performed the first miracle - changing water into wine at the wedding feast. Here, we'll invite couples to renew their wedding vows. We will then proceed to Our Lord's boyhood town, Nazareth. Here we will celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Annunciation, visit Joseph's Workshop and Mary's Well. Then take an excursion to the summit of Mt. Tabor to see the site of the Transfiguration of Jesus. (B/D)

Day 11 – June 15: Tiberias / Tel Aviv
This morning we will depart Tiberias and drive to the sparkling port city of Haifa where we will ascend
Mount Carmel, home of the prophets Elijah and
Elisha, for Mass at Stella Maris. Then continue along the Mediterranean coast to ancient Caesarea where
St. Peter preached and St. Paul was imprisoned for two years. Here we will visit the ruins of the Roman Theater, the Crusader's Moat and the Byzantine
Churches. Our drive continues to Old Jaffa where we will visit the Church of St. Peter, the home of Simon the Tanner. We will then enjoy a farewell dinner including wine at a local restaurant and then transfer to Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv to catch our late evening return flight home. (B/D)

Day 12 – June 16: Tel Aviv / U.S.A.
Depart Tel Aviv just after midnight for our flight to
Boston. We arrive back in Boston at 5:15 AM.
