Giving Trees --- Our Advent Ministry --- Advent and Christmas are times of giving. Below is a list of opportunities to give to people in our local communities. One or more of these options can be selected from the Christmas trees that will be in front of both Holy Spirit and St. Lawrence Churches throughout Advent.

Let's bring the true spirit of Christmas to our neighbors in need. God bless you for your generosity!

Visit someone in one of our local nursing homes or a shut-in in your neighborhood. Give them the gift of your time, pray with them and spread some Christmas cheer. NOTE: Check with the home prior to visiting to determine their visiting regulations.

Purchase a \$20 or larger gift card for gas. Place it in an envelope and drop off/place in drop box/mail it to the parish office or place it in the collection basket by December 18. To be given to someone in need by our local priests.

 $NOTE: Consider \ getting \ gift \ cards \ through \ Scrip \ at \ Kuemper \ to \ help \ Kuemper \ students/families \ with \ tuition, \ and \ Kuemper.$

Purchase a \$25 or larger gift card for groceries at a local store. Put it in an envelope and drop off/place in

drop box/mail it to the parish office or place it in the collection basket by December 18. To be given to someone in need by our local priests.

NOTE: Fareway has generic gift cards as well as those that specify "For Groceries Only" or "For Meat Only."

HyVee and Wal-Mart have generic gift cards only. Note: Consider getting gift cards through Scrip at Kuemper to help Kuemper students/families with tuition and to help Kuemper.

Offer a Mass or say prayers for those less fortunate than you or for someone who is suffering or alone over the Christmas season.

Put together a care package for a nursing home resident that belongs to our parish. Deliver it yourself or return it to the church by December 18.

Ideas include toothpaste, mouthwash, hand/body lotion, dental floss, a Christmas card,

warm socks or slippers with gripper bottoms, a soft and warm throw blanket, soft candy or cookies.

Purchase some groceries for our local food pantries and return them to the church by December 18. Items most needed include: tuna, canned chicken, hamburger, chicken, or tuna helper, Chunky soups, peanut butter, jelly, rice/noodle packets, pancakes, syrup.

Purchase <u>new</u> baby items and return them to the church by December 18. To be delivered to St. Anthony Hospital Nursery for new mothers in need. Ideas include: baby soap, baby lotion, small diapers, baby wipes, baby blankets, onesies, bibs, a rattle or teething toy.

Purchase some warm mittens and a warm hat and return to the church by December 18.


To be given to Kuemper teachers for students who come to school without any.
