

From the Administrator, Fr. Patrick Behm

This week, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Epiphany. This joyful celebration has particular importance in our Diocese, because it's the patronal feast day of our diocesan cathedral in Sioux City, the Cathedral of the Epiphany. The Cathedral, of course, is the mother church of the entire Diocese. When I was assigned there as associate pastor as a newly ordained priest, on occasion I would be asked to give tours of the Cathedral. One of the points that I would always try to make to each group was to say that if you are from the Diocese of Sioux City, in some sense, this is your home church. If you're ever in Sioux City, please make a point to stop and see our beautiful cathedral and perhaps participate in the celebration of the Mass while you're there.

The importance of the feast of the Epiphany is that this is the day that Jesus revealed his divinity to the world. It really encompasses three events in the life of Christ: the visit of the three magi, the Baptism of the Lord, and Christ's first public miracle where He changed water into wine at the wedding feast in Cana. Each of these three events reveal that the Person of Jesus Christ is not an ordinary human being, but rather, He is God, the Second Person of the Blessed Trinity who has assumed a human nature. As such, an encounter with Him is unlike an encounter with any other person. When we encounter another person, we encounter someone who can accompany us in various stages of life. This could be a parent, son or daughter, grandparent, boyfriend or girlfriend, spouse, best friend, or even somebody we meet once a week to play cards with. But none of those individuals are God. Jesus is God, and so our relationship with Him is necessarily different. We can talk to Him as a friend, certainly, but we also worship Him as God!

There's a key line in today's Gospel account of the visit of the three magi that indicates what our disposition towards Christ should be, "Having been warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they departed for their country by another way." When we encounter the Person of Jesus Christ, and we allow Him to impact our lives, we simply cannot go back to where we came from! There's no sin too great for Jesus to forgive, nothing so horrible to keep Him away, but when we encounter Him, we simply cannot be the same person we were before! The magi encountered Him and were changed! Let us be like the three magi! Let us encounter Jesus Christ, God Who has become human so as to dwell with us, and have our hearts and minds totally transformed by Him all encompassing love and mercy!






