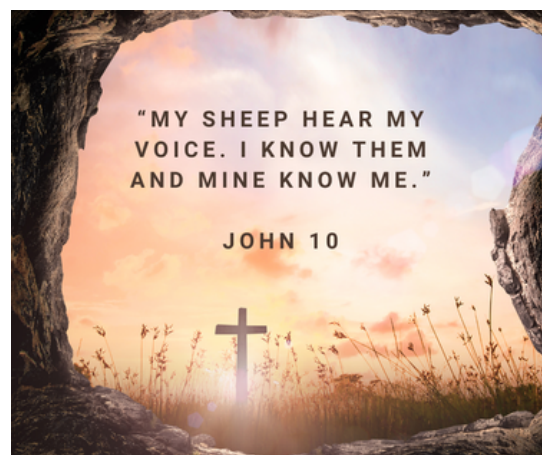

## **From the Pastor, Fr. Patrick Behm**

The Fourth Sunday of Easter is often referred to as “Good Shepherd” Sunday. Each year on this day, we read a selection from the tenth chapter of St. John’s Gospel, where Jesus refers to Himself as “the Good Shepherd.” This is often a week where the homily is focused on promoting priestly vocations, as Christ continues to call young men to come follow Him and also to be “good shepherds.” It’s also an opportunity to pray for our seminarians, that they will be open and docile to the Holy Spirit in their priestly formation. We especially remember Deacon Jake Rosenmeyer this year, who, God willing, will be ordained to the priesthood on June 7.

We all know the sad reality that the number of active priests in our diocese has declined in recent decades. According to the website, catholic-hierarchy.org, as recently as 1976, we had 200 priests serving the Diocese of Sioux City. That number dropped to 121 by 2014, and is down to 80 today. Of those 80, more than half are retired. Here in Carroll County, we are blessed to have a number of retired priests in the area who generously help to cover Masses and confessions while Fr. Peter and I are out of town, as I happen to be this weekend. We are most grateful for their dedicated service!

Many parishes and dioceses are seeing a new springtime of blossoming of priestly vocations, and I have every confidence that that joyous reality can also happen here at St. John Paul II Parish, and throughout the Diocese of Sioux City. Much could be said on how to do this, but it all comes back to the Eucharist, the “source and summit” of our faith. Since starting perpetual Eucharistic adoration in our parish, we’ve had one young man enter the seminary, and another who is applying this year. For this, we rejoice! When young people see the centrality of the Eucharist, that the Eucharist is the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ, and that we only have the Eucharist through the hands of a priest, they are very naturally drawn to consider a priestly vocation.

While no two priests are alike, there are some traits that we should look for in encouraging young men to consider a priestly vocation. Is he a man of prayer? Is he striving to grow in the virtues, especially the theological (faith, hope, and charity) and cardinal (prudence, justice, temperance, and fortitude) virtues? Does he love Christ and the Church? Does he have the intellectual gifts necessary to enter into priestly ministry? Is he a man who loves Christ and the Church? Does he have a devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary? Does he desire to be of service to others?

Certainly, no man possesses any of these gifts perfectly this side of heaven. None of us are finished products this side of heaven. But these are markers that could indicate that a young man might have a vocation to serve Christ and the Church as a priest, and to become like our Lord, “a good shepherd.”

This column has focused exclusively on the priesthood, but young women must also go through the process of discernment of their own vocations. In a future bulletin column, I’ll write about the beautiful vocation of the consecrated life.

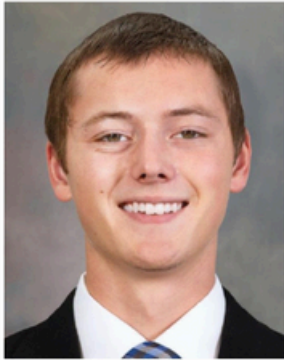
