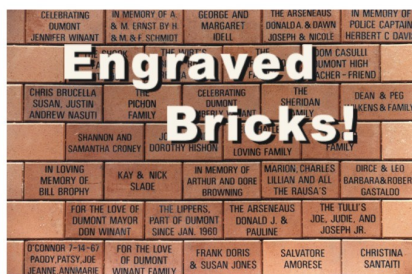

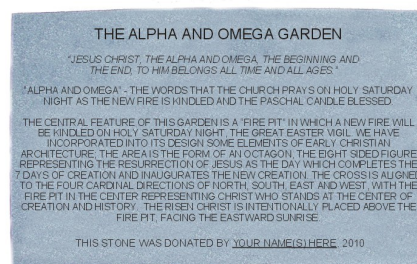

The Alpha and Omega Garden***

*"Jesus Christ, the Alpha and Omega, the Beginning and
the End; to Him belongs all time and all ages."*

"Alpha and Omega" - the words that the Church prays on Holy Saturday night as the new fire is kindled and the paschal candle blessed.



The central feature of this garden is a "fire pit" in which a new fire will be kindled on Holy Saturday night, the Great Easter Vigil. We have incorporated into its design some elements of early Christian architecture; the area is the form of an octagon, the eight sided figure representing the resurrection of Jesus as the day which completes the 7 days of creation and inaugurates the new creation. The cross is aligned to the four cardinal directions of north, south, east and west, with the fire pit in the center representing Christ who stands at the center of creation and history. The risen Christ is intentionally placed above the fire pit, facing the eastward sunrise.
