Baptisms

Baptisms are usually held on Saturday mornings anytime throughout the year (**with the exception of the Lenten Season**). Parents must be registered parishioners and complete a Baptismal Preparation class. It is required that godparents are no less than 16 years of age and have completed the three Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Holy Communion and Confirmation. If the godparents are a married couple, they need to have been married by the Catholic Church. Please contact the Parish Office to arrange for the class and the date of Baptism.

SUNDAY MASS READING 7/27

First Reading: Genesis 18:20-32

Abraham pleads with the Lord, who planned to destroy Sodom and Gomorrah because of the evil and sin in those cities. Abraham asks him if he would spare the city if fifty, forty, thirty, twenty or even only ten innocent people were found there. God says that he would spare the cities even for the sake of only ten.

Second Reading: Colossians 2:12-14

Paul explains to the Colossians that through baptism, they are raised to life with Christ because they believed in the power of the God who raised him from the dead. Even though they once lived in sin, their sins have been pardoned through Jesus.

Gospel: Luke 11:1-13

Jesus' disciples asked him how they should pray. He gave them some phrases similar to those now used in the Lord's prayer. Jesus also reminds the disciples how even men with sins are able to give good things to their children, and explains how much more the heavenly Father wants to give to us.

JULY IS DEDICATED TO THE PRECIUS BLOOD OF JESUS

JULY: MONTH OF THE PRECIOUS BLOOD

The devotion to the Precious Blood of Jesus is a rich and ancient tradition in the Catholic Church, centered on the saving power of Christ's blood poured out for humanity. This devotion invites the faithful to contemplate the immense love of Christ shown through his Passion and to deepen our gratitude for the price of our redemption.



The foundation for this devotion is deeply scriptural. In the Old Testament, the blood of sacrificial animals sealed covenants between God and his people. In the New Testament, Christ becomes the true Lamb of God whose Blood establishes the New and Eternal Covenant. St.

Paul writes in the Letter to the Hebrews: "Without the shedding of blood, there is no forgiveness of sins" (Hebrews 9:22). Jesus fulfills this by offering himself once for all, and his Blood becomes the means of our salvation.

The devotion to the Precious Blood gained formal recognition in the Church especially through the efforts of St. Gaspar del Bufalo (1786–1837), founder of the Missionaries of the Precious Blood. At a time of political and spiritual upheaval in 19th-century Italy, St. Gaspar promoted this devotion as a source of strength and renewal, preaching the power of Christ's Blood to reconcile sinners, protect the Church, and sanctify the world.

In 1849, Pope Pius IX instituted the Feast of the Precious Blood, originally celebrated on July 1st. While it was later incorporated into the Solemnity of Corpus Christi following the liturgical reforms of Vatican II, July remains the traditional month dedicated to the Precious Blood in Catholic devotion. During this time, the faithful are encouraged to reflect on the mysteries of Christ's suffering and to invoke the Precious Blood in prayer.

Common practices associated with this devotion include reciting the Litany of the Precious Blood, making acts of reparation for sins, meditating on the Seven Bloodsheddings of Christ (such as the circumcision, the agony in the garden, the scourging, and the crucifixion), and attending Mass with particular awareness of the chalice that contains Christ's Blood.

In our times, marked by spiritual dryness, fear, and division, devotion to the Precious Blood calls us back to the source of grace, healing, and unity—the love of Christ made visible in his sacrifice.

SAINT JOSEPH PARISH SEWAGE PIPING REPAIR PROJECT

You may be wondering: Why is the front yard scruffed up? On Monday, July 14, 2025, & Wed. July 15, a section of the church's original sewage piping was replaced.

The back story: Last year we had to call a plumber a couple of times to deal with pipe blockage. Different companies evaluated the state of the original piping and determined that a section of the pipes needed to be replaced sooner than later to prevent further damage and a possible bursting. Guided by the Diocesan facilities management we selected an experienced contractor they recommended.

After the job was finished, several men from our Hispanic community, led by Ramon Salazar, the

Oratory Parishes Facilities Manager and a long time St. Joseph parishioner, donated their time and talent to reseed the area.

Cost: \$21,953.77 (\$21,780.00 piping, topsoil \$173.27)
