USCCB urges Catholics to pray to St. Joseph for end of taxpayer-funded abortion

The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) has asked the faithful to invoke

Court Issues Ruling Forcing Catholic Nuns to Pay for Abortions

In a nationwide ruling against a Trump Administration religious conscience rule, a federal district court in Philadelphia today, August 13, sided with Pennsylvania and New Jersey in their yearslong effort to force the Little Sisters of the Poor—an

order of Catholic nuns who care for the elderly poor—to either provide abortion and contraceptives in their healthcare plan or pay tens of millions of dollars in fines.

In Little Sisters of the Poor v. Pennsylvania, the Supreme Court in 2020 upheld a federal rule protecting the Little Sisters and other religious groups from the federal government's contraceptive mandate. But Pennsylvania and New Jersey have continued to fight in court to strip the Little Sisters of that protection. This ruling keeps that effort alive, and the Little Sisters have vowed to appeal to the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit.

following allegations that staff at Centreville High School arranged and funded abortions for two students without notifying their parents.

The abortions, arranged in 2021, are prompting outrage from pro-life advocates who call the actions a violation of parental rights and state law. Pro-life organization 40 Days for Life condemned the reported actions on X, stating, "A Fairfax high school secretly arranged and paid for student abortions—without telling parents. This isn't 'healthcare.' It's state-funded child exploitation. Every official involved must be held accountable." Study Confirms Women Having Abortions Twice as Likely to Need Psychiatric Hospitalization

A new study of over 1.2 million pregnancy outcomes in Quebec, Canada, confirms that psychiatric hospitalization is over twice as likely to occur after induced abortions than after live births (104 versus 42 cases per 10,000 person years). The rates of hospitalization were especially higher for substance abuse disorders and suicide attempts.

The risks associated with abortion remained elevated even after controlling for prior mental health, age, and poverty. But among women with prior mental health issues, psychiatric hospitalization was nine times more likely for those who had abortions. In contrast, among women without prior mental health issues, abortion was linked to only a 50% increased risk of psychiatric hospitalization.

Planned Parenthood Once Again Caught Misleading Women in PA

Planned Parenthood is once again falsely advertising services it doesn't actually provide to Pennsylvania women, a repeat offense of a deceptive pattern first exposed in 2017.

A new review conducted by the Pennsylvania Family Institute found that multiple Planned Parenthood locations across the Commonwealth are advertising "Prenatal and Postpartum Services" on their websites, yet none of the listed clinics actually offer prenatal care.

Calls made directly to Planned Parenthood locations that claim to offer such services confirmed the truth: not one Planned Parenthood in Pennsylvania provides any prenatal care. This false advertising comes despite Planned Parenthood Keystone and Planned Parenthood of Western Pennsylvania listing "Prenatal and Postpartum Services" among their offerings at multiple health centers.

It is clear: Planned Parenthood's business model isn't about supporting women, it's about selling abortions. Taxpayer dollars shouldn't be funding an organization that continues to mislead the public and manipulate vulnerable women." HHS Finds Systemic Disregard for Sanctity of Life in Organ Transplant System

On July 21, 2025, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) under Robert F. Kennedy, Jr. announced a major push to begin reforming the U.S. organ procurement and transplantation system. This announcement was prompted by a Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) investigation that uncovered multiple examples of patients who were not dead when they were taken for organ procurement.

The HRSA investigation revealed that out of 351 cases studied, 103 (29.3 percent) were found to have problems. They discovered 73 patients (21 percent) who were authorized for organ procurement despite having neurological signs incompatible with organ donation. And disturbingly, at least 28 patients (8 percent) may not have been deceased when doctors began surgery to remove their organs.

Statistic shows abortion has wiped out 28% of Gen Z generation

Stats not just from the US but around the world indicate that about 3-in-10 babies are killed by abortion.

According to Guttmacher estimates for the number of abortions performed each year in the U.S. from 1997 to 2011, the birth years of Gen Z, about 19.5 million conceived human beings of that generation, have been killed through abortion.
