Thank you for all you do to support the Center. May God richly bless you!



Early Bird rates end Friday, May 16!





Your End is Not Your Job!

Today, everyone needs work to provide for their family.

Even though your job may provide financially, it can leave you desolate spiritually. To combat this, we must view our work through a supernatural lens, through Jesus Christ and His Cross.

Remember, your work is not who you are, and it is not your purpose in life. Your purpose, or end, is to attain to **loving union with Christ** in this life and to be with him in Heaven in the next.

Your work is a means to this end—your sanctification.

"For this is the will of God, your sanctification"

-1 Thess 4:3

Christ spent 30 years of his life in humble manual labor with St. Joseph and Mary in the house of Nazareth as a model for us of how to work to provide for our families, but this labor was a means to an end, it was not His purpose in life.

Sanctify Your Job Today With These Three Steps:

Before you begin, offer your work to God with a short prayer. Offering all the sufferings and joys for your spouse, children, or parents can be a powerful means of union with God (This type can only be cast out by prayer and fasting.)

Make time for prayer during the work week. Whether it's to pray the Rosary on your lunch break, or to assist at Holy Mass sometime during the work week, or to stop by and visit Our Lord reserved in the tabernacle on your way home. Use your lunch breaks for spiritual nourishment. Sit in silence and look upon a crucifix. Listen to a spiritual talk online or an audiobook of a Saint, read the Sacred Scriptures, or even pray the Rosary. These small actions will shower great graces upon you. **They will make your life, work, and union with God more meaningful and sanctifying!!**
