Divine Mercy Sunday, April 11, 2021 - Please join us on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 11 to pray the Chaplet at 3:00 p.m.



Jesus Himself spoke to St. Faustina Kowalska, teaching her about His great mercy towards sinners. He asked that on the Sunday following Easter a feast be solemnly celebrated. On this day, Our Lord promised that the divine floodgates through which mercy flows, would be wide open and the soul that will have gone to Confession and received Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sin and punishment. This is known as a Plenary Indulgence. Divine Mercy Sunday was fixed on the Church calendar on April 30, 2000 and has been officially recognized by the

Vatican. This devotion was close to the heart of St. John Paul II and has rapidly spread throughout the world. The Holy Father, Pope Francis, has urged us to keep in mind that we are now living in a time of mercy. Prepare for this great Feast of Mercy by praying the 9 day Chaplet of Divine Mercy Novena beginning on Good Friday. There are copies of the Divine Mercy Novena and Chaplet on the entrance tables to the Church.

Sunday, April 4, 2021 In the first reading we hear Peter proclaiming the Good News of Jesus risen from the dead and that in his lifetime, Jesus went about doing good, healing the sick and that God was with him! As disciples of Jesus, filled with grace through his resurrection, we too are called to this mission. What good are we called to do this week? Who are those, sick in mind, body, or spirit that we might minister to this week? How can we bring the presence of God to situations of injustice this
