





EIM Compliance News and Important Dates - The EIM Office is
converting the EIM database and training programs to VIRTUS
products over the next few months. To make the data conversion
process as smooth and accurate as possible:

NEW APPLICANTS: If you are new to ministry in the Diocese
of Austin and wish to serve between now and early January, 2023,
you must submit an EIM Application for Ministry
(austindiocese.org/application) BY OCTOBER 31, and attend an in-
person EIM Workshop (austindiocese.org/initial-eim-training) BY
NOVEMBER 15th.

*No new EIM applications will be accepted from November 1-
January 2, 2023.*

Beginning January 3rd, new applicants will register through VIR-
TUS Online.

There will be no EIM Workshops held between November 16
and early January 2023.

CURRENT/EXISTING APPLICANTS: If you will serve in min-
istry between now and the end of the calendar year, you must be
compliant through the end of the year by NOVEMBER 15.

There will be no online EIM training available between Novem-
ber 16 and January 2, 2023.

If you need to update/renew your compliance, online EIM train-
ing is available at (austindiocese.org/onlineeimtraining) until end of
day November 15 (you do not need to login to your EIM account to
complete the online EIM training).

If you don’t know if you are compliant or not, login to your EIM
account at eappsdb.com/austin and use the Forgot ID?Password?
links if needed, or contact your parish/school EIM site administrator,
