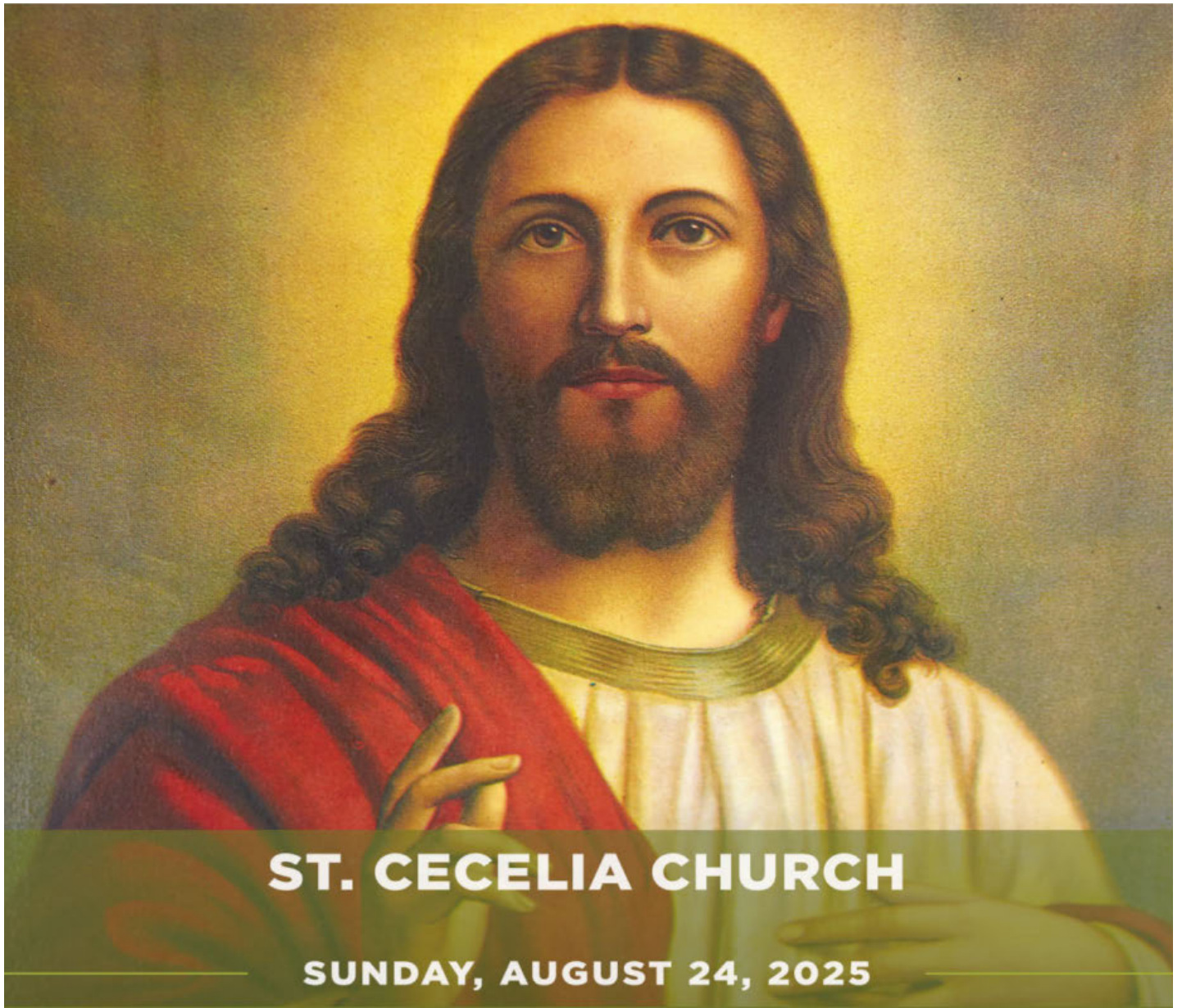

Sacraments

Sponsor Letter To be eligible as a sponsor, an individual must:

- Have received the Sacraments of Baptism, First Communion, and Confirmation.
- Be an active Catholic who is registered at St. Cecelia Parish, attends Mass regularly, supports the Church, and leads a life in accordance with the teachings of the Church.
- If married, be in a valid Christian marriage that is recognized by the Church.

We are only able to provide letters of eligibility for parishioners who meet all of the above criteria. Original Baptism and/or Confirmation certificates for both Godparents must be presented to the Parish Office. These requirements are universal laws of the Church and do not vary by parish.

First Holy Communion & Confirmation

The Order of Christian Initiation (O.C.I.A.)

O.C.I.A. is the process through which Non-Catholics who are interested in becoming members of the Roman Catholic Church and/or Baptized Catholics who wish to complete their Sacraments of Initiation are guided through prayer, instruction, and community support. Classes will begin the second week of September. For more information, please contact: Sister Anna at (732) 283-2816.

Marriage Preparation:

Registered parishioners may begin making wedding arrangements **at least one year** in advance of the proposed wedding date. **Please note:** The Church must confirm and approve the wedding date **before** any other wedding plans are finalized. To begin the process, please contact the Parish Office at 732-283-2300 to schedule an appointment with a priest and secure your date.

Wedding Etiquette

Remember, when entering the Church, for your rehearsal or wedding, it is a place of worship and proper reverence is expected at all times. All preparations and rehearsals will be coordinated in advance with the Priest who will be officiating the wedding.

Floral Arrangements:

- * May not be placed in front of the altar.
- * They may be placed on the sides, in front of the pulpit, or somewhere else in the sanctuary.
- * Do not use tape, glue, putty, staples or wire on the pews to attach flowers or ribbons.

Additional Restrictions:

- * Throwing rice, rose petals, confetti, bird seed, or any other materials that leave residue is not permitted.
- * Pets are not allowed with the exception of service animals.

Ministry to the Sick or Homebound:

If a loved one is in need of a priest for the Sacraments, please contact the Parish Office any time at 732-283-2300. Our priests are always on call to serve those in need. For regular Communion, visits to the sick, elderly, or homebound, please make arrangements in advance through the Parish Office.

If you would like Fr. Deniskingsley or Fr. Ignatius to bless your home, please call the Parish Office to schedule an appointment. This would be a wonderful opportunity for our Priests to meet with parishioners and for families to receive a special blessing!

Walking the Narrow Path with God's Discipline and Love

Brothers and sisters in Christ, today's readings invite us to think about what it means to walk through the "narrow gate." In the Gospel (13: 22-30), Jesus tells us that the way to heaven is not wide and easy, but narrow and demanding. This does not mean God wants to make life difficult for us. Instead, it means that the path to eternal life requires effort, discipline, and love. It requires us to live as true followers, not just people who say they know Him.

In the first reading from the prophet Isaiah (66:18-21), God promises to gather people from every nation into his kingdom. This is a beautiful reminder that heaven is not closed off to anyone. No matter where we come from, no matter our age or background, God invites us. For children, this means that even in the simple act of sharing toys or listening to parents, you are already living the way of God. For young people, it may mean choosing honesty with your friends, resisting peer pressure, or serving in the parish choir or altar service. For parents, it could mean showing patience in raising children, forgiving when tensions arise at home, and working hard with honesty to provide for the family. For grandparents and elders, it may mean offering wisdom, prayer, and encouragement to the younger ones, being witnesses of faith and perseverance. God's invitation is wide, but the path to answer it is narrow. It requires real choices every day.

The second reading from Hebrews (12:5-7, 11-13) tells us that sometimes God allows discipline in our lives. Just as a good parent or teacher corrects a child for their growth, God shapes us through challenges. A student may not like studying for an exam, but discipline leads to success. An athlete does not enjoy training early mornings, but the effort wins the prize. A worker may feel the weight of long hours, but it is in that faithful effort that the family is supported. And in spiritual life, prayer, fasting, forgiveness, and self-control are not always easy, but they shape us into strong disciples. God's discipline is not punishment. It is love guiding us back to the narrow gate.

In the Gospel, Jesus warns us that it is not enough to say, "Lord, I know You." Faith is not just words; it must be lived in action. This is a message for all of us. As a community, we must ask these questions. Do our neighbors see our Catholic faith in the way we act? As children, do your classmates and friends see kindness in you? As youths, do your friends see courage and faith in your choices? As parents, do your children see patience, love, and prayer in your home? Elders, do your families see in you the light of hope and wisdom? These are the ways we walk along the narrow path. It is not by empty talk, but by daily living that reflects Christ.

So, the message today is clear. God's invitation is for everyone, but entering his kingdom means walking the narrow path of love, discipline, and faith. It is not always easy for us, but it is something always worth it. We can do it, trusting in God. At times, we may stumble, but the sacraments, especially Confession and the Eucharist, give us strength to keep going. Let us encourage one another as one family of faith: children, youth, parents, and elders, all walking together through the narrow gate. If we persevere, we will share in the joy of God's eternal feast, where people from every nation will gather around his table.

Let us pray for the grace to remain strong, to live our faith in action, and to walk daily on the narrow path that leads us to heaven. Amen.

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

¿Has intentado alguna vez o has tenido la experiencia de entrar por alguna puerta angosta? Es incómodo y te sientes apretado si intentan entrar más de dos personas al mismo tiempo. Nos gustan las puertas anchas, altas y bonitas. La puerta angosta es para entrar de uno en uno, no más. "Esfuércense por entrar por la puerta angosta, porque yo les digo que muchos tratarán de entrar y no lo lograrán" (Lucas 13:24). La manera de hablar de Jesús es diferente a otras ocasiones. Habla claro y directo: dice "esfuércense". Nada es fácil; moldear la arcilla de lo que estamos hechos requiere de esfuerzo.

El Evangelio de hoy también nos advierte: "Unos que estaban entre los últimos son ahora los primeros, mientras que los primeros han pasado a ser los últimos" (Lucas 13:30). ¡Qué sorpresa tan grande! Dios no nos reconocerá por nuestros títulos ni por los puestos de importancia en la sociedad, mucho menos por la riqueza y las propiedades. Así que, ahora sí, se comprende el mensaje de esforzarse para entrar por la puerta angosta. "Ahora considero un deber mío explicarles por qué la puerta es angosta. Cualesquiera que desee entrar, primero, y antes que nada, tiene que poseer una fe honrada e incontaminada; en segundo lugar, una vida sin mancha, sin pecado, en la que no existan posibilidades de culpa, conforme a la medida de la justicia humana" (San Cirilo de Alejandría, 375-444, Comentario al Evangelio de San Lucas).

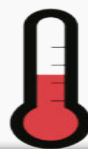
