I would like to inform you that the celebration of the Holy Eucharist from Monday, March 27th - 30th will take place at the Parish Hall due to cleaning and preparation of the Church for Holy Week. On this day, we will have Holy Hour of Adoration after Mass, and then the Blessed Sacrament will be reposed. Furthermore, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed one hour before the healing Mass and pray the Holy Rosary as usual at 6:30 PM closing with Benediction and Holy Mass.

There will be **NO MASSES** at the parish. We invite all parishioners to participate in the Chrism Mass at St. Paul's Cathedral. In this beautiful celebration, Bishop McManus will consecrate the three oils all the parishes will use for the celebration of the Sacraments.

Furthermore, on this day there is **no Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament**, which is reserved for Holy Thursday after the celebration of the Last Supper of the Lord.

## **Evening of the Lord's Supper**

**Mass will be celebrated at 7 PM.** After the celebration of the Holy Eucharist, we invite people too solemnly and devoutly process in prayer and singing to the altar of repose, which will be located at the parish hall. This procession will be done outside the Church leaving through the main door and walking around towards the main entrance of the hall. The hall will be opened for personal prayer until midnight.

## **Holy Friday, April 7th** **Good Friday**

The celebration of the Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ will take place at 7 PM at the church. The celebration of the Seven Last Words of Jesus on the Cross will take place right after the ceremony and close with night prayer at the church hall.

## **Holy Saturday, April 8th**

The Easter Vigil will be celebrated at 7:30 PM. It will start with the blessing of the fire in the front of the church and process with the Easter Candle into the church. We invite all the elderly people and those with mobility difficulties to wait in the church as the church will be in darkness.

Please, do not hesitate and join us for this important and transcendental celebration. It is only once a year in which we have the opportunity to see how the Old and the New Testament are brought to fulfillment in the person of Jesus Christ. Furthermore, on this day, our new parishioner Kayla Light-Pereira is receiving the Sacraments of Baptism, Communion and Confirmation. This event is of great happiness not only for us as St. Anthony of Padua, but also for the Universal Church who will adhere many new members to Her on this day.
