Pilgrims are not tourists, pilgrims are people on a journey designed to take them outside their everyday, familiar lives into an unfamiliar environment, where they have the opportunity to encounter the extraordinary, and thereby experience God in a new way.



Highlights include: Tour of the Vatican Basilica (with an optional tour of the Vatican Museum and Sistine Chapel*) a walking tour of Rome, tours of the Basilicas of Saints Francis and Clare, and the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli (and other sights relevant to the lives of Francis and Clare in Assisi), the Basilica of St. Anthony (and other sights relevant to the saint's life in Padua). Free day in Venice. Trip includes all flights, hotels, meals, tours*, transportation. Daily mass with Fr. Moreno and time for prayer and
