MONEY MATTERS



Cathedraticum. - noun. A sum of money paid by parishes within the diocese to underwrite diocesan wide expenditures.

Since the late 1800's, this calculation has been traditionally known as an assessment proportional to the annual income of a parish.

Currently, each parish in the Diocese is required to remit 11% of its annual collections to the Diocese of Worcester. During our last fiscal year, St. Anthony of Padua's assessment amounted to \$22,193.

Tithing is a tribute to God; your weekly gifts have shown your faith and trust in His name. We, at St. Anthony of Padua, are most grateful you've chosen us as your home.
