
Sign up for Project 60

Our Mission as Extraordinary Eucharistic Ministers at St. Anthony is to participate in the sharing of the body and blood of Jesus Christ with the parish community.



To provide competent, well-educated, spiritually formed and pastorally skilled deacons who will work with the Bishop, priests, and lay pastoral leaders to meet the ministerial needs of the people of the Diocese of Worcester. To enable these deacons to be an integral part of the overall plan of meeting the pastoral needs of the people in the Diocese of Worcester.

GUIDELINES FOR FAST AND ABSTINENCE

Lenten fast and abstinence regulations for the Diocese of Worcester are as follows:

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics fourteen (14) years of age and older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent.

Fasting is to be observed by all Catholics who are eighteen (18) years of age but not yet fifty-nine (59) years of age on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Those who are bound to fast may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

During the October timeframe, our electricity costs (church) were close to \$750. During December these costs were in excess of \$1,800.

For the same period in October, our propane (gas) costs (rectory) were near \$300. For the month of December our propane costs approached \$700.

We cannot forget our plowing costs which are close to \$4,200 winter to date.
