


The disciples have shamefully run away and abandoned the One who loved with the greatest Love. How about you? Are you running away just as the disciples did?

After the liturgy of the Passion we will celebrate the Seven Last Words of Jesus on the Cross and will finish with Night Prayer at the parish hall.

This liturgy is very important as the continuation of Holy Thursday. Jesus is giving up His life for our sake. He is satisfying the thirst of the unjust with His blood in order to deliver the just. The Hour of None, 3 O'clock becomes the darkest time of history because for the Enemy it was its triumph over God. However, we know that it was God conquering again the hearts of His creation. This sacrifice of Love becomes the eternal and unrepeatable sign of the eternal Covenant between God and His creation.



Holy Saturday – March 30 Easter Vigil at 7:30 PM

This is the "closing" of the Holy Triduum" The Liturgy in which we bless the Easter Candle, sign of our Risen Lord, True Light who has come to illumine our lives, thus driving us

out of darkness. This beautiful celebration of the Holy Eucharist is a reminder that Jesus did not remain on a Cross, He did not remained in a cold and dark tomb, but rather has come out of Death bringing Eternal Glory.

During the October timeframe, our electricity costs (church) were close to \$750. During December these costs were in excess of \$1,800.

For the same period in October, our propane (gas) costs (rectory) were near \$300. For the month of December our propane costs approached \$700.

We cannot forget our plowing costs which are close to \$4,200 winter to date.


