

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This past week, Bishop Checchio celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation for 107 of our young men and women. Truly it was a joyful celebration of the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. I wish to express my gratitude for Bishop Checchio's pastoral leadership during these uncertain times.

These past two years of the COVID pandemic have interrupted our regular parish life and ministries. Now, as April begins we are in the process of training new Altar Servers, Readers and Eucharistic Ministers. Our Choir has also resumed its music ministry at the Noon Mass on Sundays and they are busy preparing for the liturgies of Holy Week and Easter.

The renovation work on the Church is progressing: this week the last four stain glassed windows were installed. The electricians were here to complete the lighting in the Church. The work on the choir loft is complete and the organ is in place with its new speaker system.

As of Tuesday, March 29th, parishioners have pledged \$101,142.00 to the Bishops Annual Appeal. Our goal is \$173,000.00. Please prayerfully consider making a contribution to the Appeal. Thank you.

"THE EUCHARIST AND COMMUNION"


WEDNESDAY, 6 APRIL 7:00 P.M.

The "Hunger Cloth"

Did you know?

Towards the end of Lent you may notice purple cloths draped over the crucifixes, statues, and saint images at your parish. In some churches, these items may be removed from the sanctuary altogether. This old custom of veiling religious images is a way of focusing on the penitential aspect of this liturgical season. It reminds us in a visual way that our faith in all its glory is made possible only through the work of Christ in his suffering and death on the cross. When we cover or remove these holy and sacred images that we are so accustomed to, we are starkly confronted and reminded in a poignant way of all that Christ has won for us. The tradition is often practiced during the last two weeks before Easter, starting on Passion Sunday (now called the fifth Sunday of Lent) and ending on Good Friday. This time period is known on the old liturgical calendar as *Passiontide*. Even though this period is no longer officially called by this name, the tradition is still practiced in many places. Then, as in a dramatic unveiling, the holy images are again revealed for the Easter Vigil to mark the end of the penitential season. The joy of the Easter season and the hope of the Resurrection then comes to the forefront. Temporarily veiling the crosses and religious images in the penitential color of Lent is a beautiful custom that helps us to re-
