

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The month of August is named for the Emperor Caesar Augustus, first emperor of the Roman Empire, who reigned from 27 BC until his death in the year 14 Anno Domini. The reign of Augustus initiated an imperial cult and an era of peace, called the Pax Romana. During his reign, Jesus Christ was born in Bethlehem of Judea, (3 BC/1 AD). He is mentioned in the Gospel of Saint Luke, "In those days a decree went out from Caesar Augustus that all the world should be registered." His reign is significant because it provides a historical context for the birth of Jesus.

Our summer lecture series was focused on the life and teaching of Saint Augustine of Hippo, (354-430 AD). Raised in North Africa, he was a citizen of the Roman Empire along with his parents, Patricius and Monica. Augustine was named for the great emperor but through the grace of God would come to serve the Kingdom of Christ as a Priest and Bishop of the Catholic Church. His books, "The Confessions" and "The City of God" would have a profound impact on Christians throughout the centuries.

This weekend we bid "arrivederci" to Bruce Cargill, our seminarian who will return to Rome to pursue his studies for the priesthood. Bruce is a third year theology student at the North American College in Rome. I am very grateful for his assistance with our liturgies and his presentation on Saint Augustine's Theology of Grace. Please keep Bruce and all our seminarians in your prayers.

Here are two prayers from Saint Augustine:

**YOU ARE GREAT, LORD, AND GREATLY TO BE PRAISED; GREAT IS YOUR POWER, AND TO YOUR WISDOM THERE IS NO END. AND MAN, BEING PART OF YOUR CREATION, DESIRES TO PRAISE YOU – MAN, WHO CARRIES WITH HIM HIS MORTALITY, THE WITNESS of his sin and the witness that you resist the proud. Yet man, this part of your creation, desires to praise you. You move us to delight in praising you, for you have formed us for yourself; and our hearts are restless until they find rest in you.**

**LATE HAVE I LOVED YOU**, fairness so ancient and so new; late have I loved you! For behold you were within me and I was without, and there did I seek you. In my unfair state I rushed heedlessly among the beautiful things of your creation. You were with me, but I was not with you. Those things kept me far from you, though they had no true existence except in you. You called and cried aloud, and forced open my deafness. You sent forth your beams and shone, and chased away my blindness. You breathed fragrance, and I drew in my breath and now do sigh after you. I tasted, and now do hunger and thirst after you. You touched me, and I burn for your peace.

**Decree on Designating Sacred Places for the Jubilee Indulgence  
In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.**

**To All the Faithful in Christ,**

The Apostolic Penitentiary, by decree dated May 13, 2024, has graciously granted the faithful the opportunity to obtain a Jubilee Indulgence through pilgrimage and prayer. In response to this, and in accordance with the directives of the Holy See, I, James Francis Checchio, Bishop of Metuchen, hereby designate the following sacred places within the Diocese of Metuchen as places where the faithful may obtain the Jubilee Indulgence:

- **Cathedral of St. Francis of Assisi, Metuchen, NJ**
- **Shrine Chapel of the Blessed Sacrament, Raritan, NJ**
- **National Blue Army Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima, Washington, NJ**
- **National Shrine of St. Lucy Filippini (inside St. Mary of Mt. Virgin Church), New Brunswick, NJ**

These sacred spaces have been carefully chosen to reflect the spiritual significance of pilgrimage and to foster deeper conversion and reconciliation among the people of God. The visit is not merely an outward action but a reflection of the soul's pilgrimage toward God, with conversion, reconciliation, and renewal at its heart. Thus, the faithful may obtain the Jubilee Indulgence by fulfilling the following conditions:

- Reception of Holy Communion
- Prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father
- A sincere intention to detach from all sin, even venial sin, and, if necessary, going to confession
- Participating in liturgical celebrations or other designated religious activities connected to the Jubilee Year.  
*in some cases, those unable to travel may fulfill the requirements through other means, such as prayers at home.*

The period for obtaining the Jubilee Indulgence will coincide with the Jubilee Year, as outlined by the Holy See beginning the 8th of December 2024 and will end on the 8th of December 2025.

I encourage all of the faithful, during this time of grace, to take the opportunity for sacramental confession, so that the Jubilee Indulgence may be received in the spirit of true reconciliation with God and the Church.


