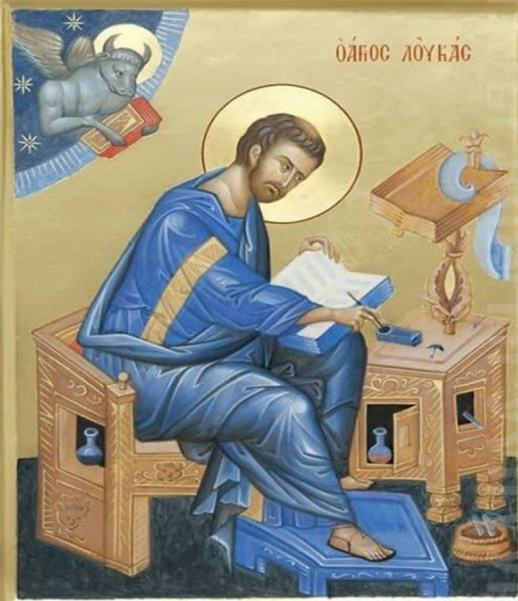

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Throughout this past year, the Gospel of Saint Luke has been proclaimed on the Sundays of Ordinary Time. Luke is the dear and glorious physician, a Gentile disciple of Saint Paul. Saint Luke wrote one of the major portions of the New Testament, a two-volume work comprising the third Gospel and the Acts of the Apostles. In these two books he shows the parallel between the life of Christ and the life of the Church.

Luke appears in Acts during Paul's second journey, remains at Philippi for several years until Paul returns from his third journey. He accompanies Paul to Jerusalem where they meet with Peter and the other Apostles. He remains with Paul during his imprisonment at Caesarea. During these two years, Luke had time to seek information and interview persons who had known Jesus. He accompanied Paul on the dangerous journey to Rome where Paul would be martyred.

Luke's unique character may best be seen by the emphases of his Gospel, which has been given a number of subtitles:

1. The Gospel of Mercy
2. The Gospel of Universal Salvation
3. The Gospel of the Poor
4. The Gospel of Absolute Renunciation
5. The Gospel of Prayer and the Holy Spirit
6. The Gospel of Joy

I would add to this list that it is also called the Gospel of Mary and the Women Disciples. Saint Luke's infancy narrative is written from Mary's perspective, including the accounts of the Annunciation, Visitation, and the Birth of Jesus at Bethlehem. What would the Christmas Story be without Saint Luke?

Saint Luke, pray for us. Amen

Vocations Corner



✦ A Journey with Deacon Jack ✦

This Deacon Sunday, we are blessed to share with you the faithful ministry of Deacon Jack Kenny. Through his dedication, compassion, and joyful service, he brings Christ's love and healing to our parish and community. As we celebrate his vocation, we invite you to learn more about his journey, his heart for service, and the many ways he reflects God's love in action. Deacon Jack Kenny's story is a beautiful reminder that God often speaks to us quietly, through the ordinary moments of our lives.

Born in 1953, Jack grew up in New Brunswick as the fourth of five children. In 1977, he moved to East Brunswick with his wife, Judy—the love of his life. Together, they raised three children and are now blessed with six grandchildren. At St. Bartholomew, Jack immersed himself in parish life—teaching Religious Education and coaching in the parish sports program. He loved working with children and families, but over time, Jack felt a stirring in his heart: Was God asking him to do more?

That question lingered until one Sunday when Jack accompanied his mother to Mass at St. Peter's in New Brunswick. By God's providence, the guest speaker that day spoke about the diaconate and invited the men of the parish to consider whether they might be called to serve. Jack recognized this as a sign and decided to answer the invitation. He wrote to Monsignor Alliegro, who was honored to sponsor him into the diaconate program.

Becoming a deacon required deep commitment: four years of formation, study, and sacrifice. Jack recalls how challenging it was to return to school after many years away, but with the support of his coworkers, family, and parish, he persevered. The process meant giving up coaching and even stepping down from his union position in the Plumbers and Pipefitters Local #9, where he remained a proud member for 52 years. Yet he describes his formation as a "most wonderful experience," filled with excellent courses and lifelong friendships with fellow candidates.

Deacon Jack was ordained on June 13, 1998, and joyfully assigned to serve at St. Bartholomew, where he has faithfully ministered for more than 25 years. He continues to serve our parish community with dedication and love through his preaching, sacramental ministry, and presence in parish life.

Jack's journey reminds us that God's call often unfolds slowly, through prayer, trust, and openness to the Spirit. His story encourages all of us to reflect on the quiet ways God might be inviting us—whether through the diaconate, priesthood, religious life, or holy marriage—to serve Him more deeply.

East Brunswick Houses of Worship to Host Symposium on the Gaza Humanitarian Crisis

Several houses of worship from across East Brunswick are uniting to host a public event,

"Symposium on the Humanitarian Crisis in Gaza"

**Sunday, October 19, at 4:45 PM
Trinity Presbyterian Church,
367 Cranbury Rd, E. Brunswick, NJ.**

Jointly organized by the **Islamic Center of East Brunswick (ICEB)**, **Trinity Presbyterian Church, East Brunswick Community Church**, and **St. Bartholomew Roman Catholic Church**, the symposium will focus on the urgent humanitarian needs of Gaza's civilian population and ways communities within the US can respond with aid, advocacy, and education.

"The crisis in Gaza demands a response rooted in our deepest human and spiritual values," the sponsoring houses of worship said in a joint statement. **"When suffering reaches this magnitude, we have a moral obligation to open our doors for education, empathy, and action in support of the innocent."**

The program features faith leaders, justice advocates, and a medical professional, **Dr. Ahmad Yousaf**, who will share insights from his recent medical mission to Gaza.

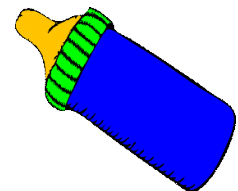
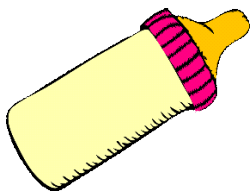
Bake Sale October 18-19th

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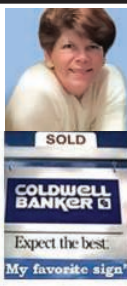


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
