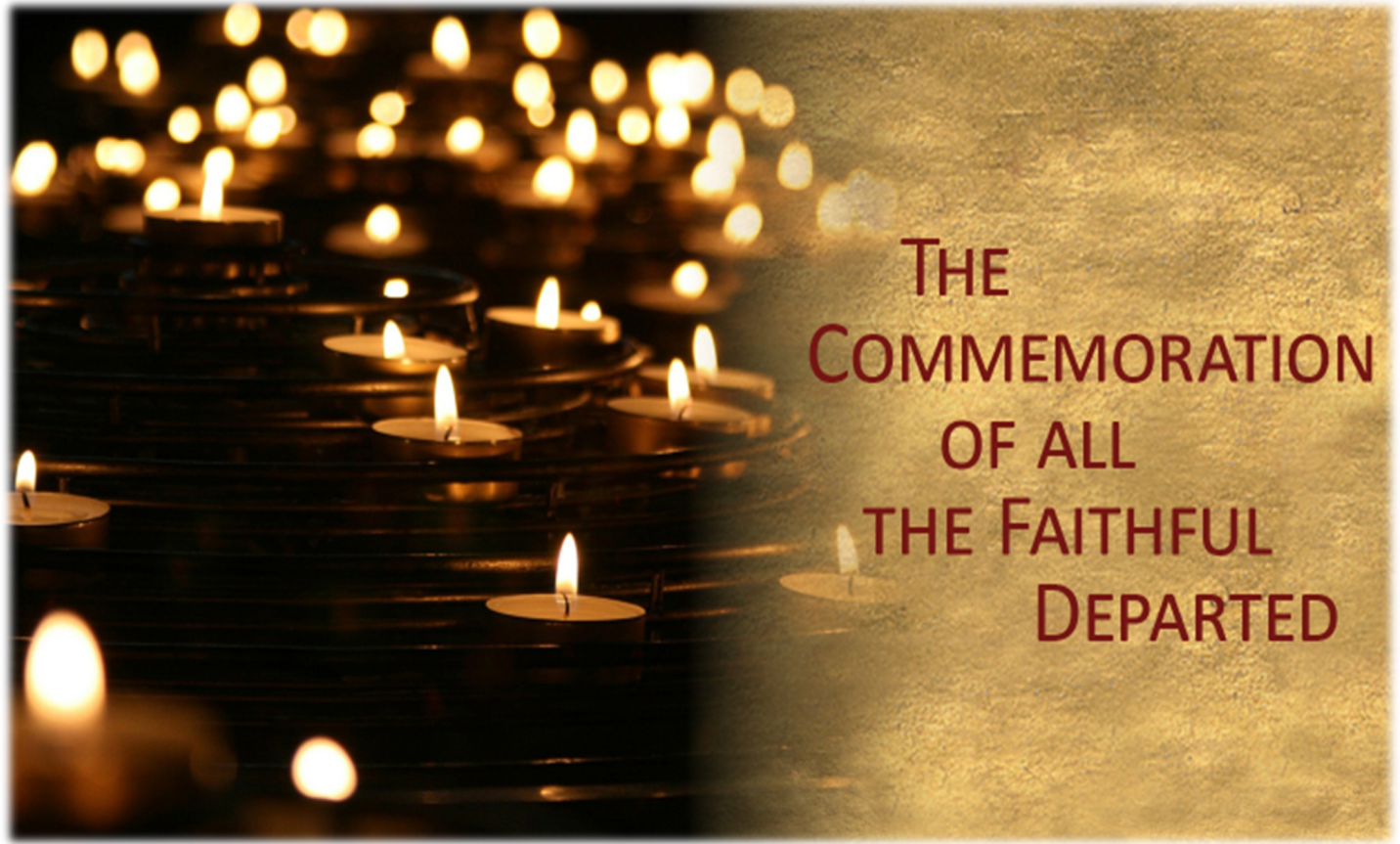

As November begins, we prepare to celebrate the season of the harvest and like our ancestors, begin to prepare for the Winter.
