Gift of Stock and Securities

There are many ways to make a gift in support of the Diocese of Fargo. A gift of stock and securities can benefit you in two ways: you may receive a charitable income tax deduction for the full fair market value of the securities, while avoiding capital gains taxes on appreciated stock.

In order to make a gift of securities, please alert us in advance.

Gifts cannot be properly acknowledged or designated without advance notice of who is making the gift, its designation, and the number of shares being transferred.

Upon the transfer of the securities, or if your broker has any questions, please phone Scott Hoselton in the Finance Office at 701-356-7930 or send a letter to the Diocese of Fargo, 5201 Bishops Blvd. S, Suite A, Fargo, ND 58104-7605, Attn: Scott Hoselton, along with the following information:

• Your name	• The number of shares and the name of the securities delivered
• Your address	• Originating Broker
• Your parish	• God's Gift Appeal

If you prefer instead, you may email the information to scott.hoselton@fargodiocese.org. This will ensure that you will receive proper credit and an acknowledgment letter stating the market value of your donation.

- **Gifts from the Harvest/Livestock**

- **Gifts from Retirement Accounts**

An IRA owner, age 70 ½ or older, can directly transfer up to \$111,000 in 2026 to an eligible charity tax-free. This option can be used for distributions from IRAs, regardless of whether the owners itemize their deductions. To qualify, funds must be transferred directly by the IRA trustee to God's Gift Appeal. Distributed amount may be excluded from the IRA's income, resulting in lower taxable income for the IRA holder.

- **Donor Advised Funds**

Individuals that have a donor advised fund can direct donations to God's Gift Appeal, as it is a charitable entity.



Tips for a Successful Appeal

An effective presentation can contribute greatly to the success of a new program or the launch of a campaign such as the *Diocese of Fargo God's Gift Appeal*. It is an opportunity to shed light and share timely information about our Church's ministries and services to our faith communities, to relay updates or stories or offer an inspiring message, to generate parish community support, and to acquire new donors or volunteers.

As you prepare to present information about the 2026 God's Gift Appeal to your parish community, below are tips that may be useful in delivering your presentation:

- **Be prepared** and have a good understanding of how the gifts to the GGA benefit the many ministries it supports.
- Show **strong, active leadership** and involvement of the pastor.
- Recruit an **effective GGA leadership committee**.
- **Strive for high participation** by pointing out that every person is asked to respond to the appeal.
- Suggest a **specific, increased gift**. Tithing guideline is 5% to Parish, 1% to Diocese, and 4% to other charities.
- **Emphasize pledges** rather than one-time gifts.
- Use and prominently **display publicity materials**.
- **Conduct a follow-up effort** and include components designed to reach a high level of participation.
- **Education and communication!** When GGA volunteers understand the importance for all of the vital programs made possible by the GGA and share this information with parishioners, the appeal is sure to be successful.
- **Show gratitude!** We cannot say thank you enough to those who support the GGA. Look for opportunities to thank them again. Remember that the success of every future appeal depends on this simple yet powerful gesture.

Kickoff Weekend: February 7-8, 2026

Steps to ensure a successful Kickoff Weekend

1. Display God's Gift Appeal posters at the entrance of your parish
2. Include Bulletin Announcements prior and on launch of the Appeal
3. Include God's Gift Appeal materials at the back of your parish:
Brochures, In-Pew Envelopes

Steps for a successful collection:

1. Please place in-pew envelopes in an area easily accessible to parishioners, i.e. pews, vestibule, etc. Ensure that ushers refill these spots with in-pew envelopes before each Mass.
2. Conduct the in-pew talk after the homily. Please do not leave the talk for the end as some people may have to leave Mass early.
3. Your message should be personalized and engaging. The more effectively you connect the Appeal with a message that will resonate with your parishioners, the more likely they will respond. Lay witness presentations can be used to give firsthand stewardship experiences and explain the importance of the programs funded by the appeal. This designated weekend also educates unregistered churchgoers, who have not received the Bishop's mailing about God's Gift Appeal.

Presentation of the Video

The video you have just seen shares the impact of your gift. Now more than ever, your support is needed to fulfill the mission of the Church within our thirty counties.

Guide Parishioners through Gift/Pledge Process

1. Parishioners may give via the in-pew envelopes provided to the parish. Donors may make a one-time gift or a pledge (for which they will receive monthly reminder statements). In-pew envelopes should be collected by the parish and sent to the diocese.
2. Parishioners are encouraged to give online at: www.fargodiocese.org/godsgiftappeal. There they may select to make a gift or pledge. *The parish listed on your pledge card that you received in the mail will receive the credit for your contribution.* If this parish is incorrect, please call 701-356-7925 to update your records.

Parish Leadership Roles

Pastor

The Pastor provides leadership, expertise, direction and oversight to the appeal, and is essential to the success of the God's Gift Appeal at the parish.

- Introduces and endorses the video message during Kick-off Weekend or Education Weekend and instructs other celebrants to do the same.
- Instructs and assures that the methods to conduct the campaign are fully implemented.
- Recruitment of a lay speaker(s) for Education Weekend.
- Include petition prayers at Mass for the success of God's Gift Appeal.
- Encourage all parishioners to consider a generous gift in gratitude for all that the Lord has given them.
- Encourage the use of the pre-printed pledge card and response envelopes.
- Be familiar with ministries and programs that benefit from God's Gift Appeal.
- Provide timely updates during the active phase of the Appeal, from the pulpit and weekly bulletin.

Pastor Follow-Up Techniques

1. However possible, each parish is encouraged to conduct its own follow-up. God's Gift Appeal statistics prove that a letter, visit, or call from a member of the parish, especially the pastor, is more effective than the follow-up conducted by the Development Office.
2. Pastors send out at least one follow-up letter to parishioners with regards to the Appeal. There is a sample letter on the following page or you can create your own letter. Please send your follow-up letter to the Stewardship and Development Office by so it is received by March 14.

The more effectively you connect the Appeal with a message that will resonate with your parishioners, the more likely they will respond.

The diocese will send the Pastor's follow-up letter to all non-contributors.

Parish Secretary/Lay Leadership

- Assist the pastor with rollout and appeal timetable.
- Making sure the God's Gift Appeal video is shown on Kick-off or Education Weekend.
- Making the Lay Speaker pulpit presentation, if requested by the pastor.
Lay testimony is very effective.
- Encourage parishioners to participate in the God's Gift Appeal.
- As needed, coordinate weekly meetings (does not have to be long) with your pastor, leader(s) and parish volunteers to ensure the successful completion of your God's Gift Appeal.

FAQ

1. Who benefits from God's Gift Appeal?

Every parish and all people within them benefit from the God's Gift Appeal, as well as those who turn to the diocese for charitable and spiritual assistance.

2. What is the goal of the God's Gift Appeal?

The goal of the 2026 God's Gift Appeal is **\$3,886,500**, however, the needs of the diocese far exceed **\$3,886,500**. It will be to the benefit of the ministries that are supported by the God's Gift Appeal to be as successful as possible.

3. How can I make a gift to God's Gift Appeal?
