IMPORTANCE OF USING WEEKLY ENVELOPES

In addition to simple recordkeeping, the primary reason we utilize any envelope system at all is so we can produce statements for parishioners at the end of each year for income tax purposes. Secondarily, because of the large size of our parish, this system allows us to track, although imperfectly, the regularity of attendance. Since we cannot possibly know each individual personally, this system is used to assist the pastor when persons request a sponsorship letter for Baptisms and Confirmations when they are not personally known to him. The sponsorship letter requires the pastor to attest to the fact that the sponsor fulfills their fundamental obligation as a Catholic by participation in the sacramental life of the Church, which includes our Sunday Mass obligation. It is precisely for this reason we request individuals to utilize our envelopes whether or not they choose or are able to donate since we can verify regular participation should they not be familiar to us.

As a parish, we strive to be good stewards of our resources. Many families have moved away from envelopes and are now using *Faith Direct* to fulfill their generous stewardship commitments to our parish and the wider church through electronic donations. We have also found that many are not using their envelopes that we mail out. WHY IS MAY "MARY'S MONTH"?

In his 1965 encyclical, Mense Maio, Pope Paul VI identified the month pf May as an opportune time to incorporate special prayers for peace into traditional May devotions. There is no firm structure as to the content of a May devotion. It usually includes the singing of Marian anthems, readings from the scriptures, and a sermon. Although prayers likely included the recitation of the Hail Mary, the rosary itself is not usually a part of this particular devotion. Catholics offer Mary in May: pilgrimages, visits to churches dedicated to her, little sacrifices in her honor, periods of study and well-finished work offered up to her, and a more attentive recitation of the rosary. The last devotion on May 31 is often followed by a solemn procession, during which a statue or portrait of the Virgin Mary is carried back into the church. Some May devotions may take place outside in a forest or a dedicated special place. One particular practice characteristic of May devotions is the May Altar, whether in a church or as a "house altar" in the home. Marian devotions such as the rosary may take place within the family around this altar consisting of a table with a Marian picture, candles, and decorated with many May flowers The custom of the May Altar stems from southern European countries. With the development of May Altars in churches, the custom spread to set up this type of :altar" also in the home. This specific devotion has been supported be several popes including Pope Pius XII in his encyclical Ingruentium malorun: The custom of the family recitation of the Holy Rosary is a most efficacious means. What a sweet sight- most pleasing to God when, at eventide, the Christian home resounds with the frequent repetition of praises in honor of the High Queen of Heaven! Then the Rosary, recited in the family, assembled before the image of the Virgin, in an admirable union of hearts, the parents and their children, who come back from their daily work. It unites them piously with those absent and those dead. It links all more tightly in a sweet bond of love, with the most Holy Virgin, who like a loving mother, in the circle of her children, will be there bestowing upon them an abundance of the gifts of concord and family peace

NEW JERSEY SAFE HAVEN LAW

Under the New Jersey Safe Haven Infant Protection Act a person may give up an unwanted infant anonymously. The purpose of Safe Haven is to protect unwanted babies from being hurt or killed from unsafe abandonment. A distressed parent who is unable to care for an infant can give up custody of a baby less than 30 days old safely, legally, and anonymously. All that is required is that the baby be brought to any hospital emergency room, police station, fire station, ambulance, first aid, and rescue squads in New Jersey that are staffed 24 hours a day, seven days a week. As long as the child shows no signs of intentional abuse, no name or other information is required. The parent can call the Safe Haven Hotline-1-877-839-2339- and get the address and directions for any hospital emergency room, police station, fire house, ambulance, first aid, and rescue squad in the state.

ENVELOPE GIVING

We are extremely thankful for the weekly stewardship of all our parishioners. During this state of emergency it is very helpful to be able to rely on your continued support even when you cannot personally attend Mass.

THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on Sundays, 1:15 pm A Preparation Session for the persons (Godparents invited) takes place prior to Baptism and is held on the First Friday of each month at 7:30 pm. A Catholic Godparent must be a practicing Catholic, i.e. one who is free to receive the Sacraments in the Catholic Church, who has been Confirmed and can receive a "Letter of Good Standing" from their parish. One Godparent could be a baptized Christian (not baptized in the Catholic Church). That Godparent will be noted in the Church record as a Christian Witness. Contact the Parish Office at 735-7319 for all arrangements and before the selection of Godparents.

SPONSOR LETTERS

Certificates of eligibility for sponsorship for Baptism of Confirmation will be given **only to active** (weekly Mass attendance) Registered parishioners.

THE SACRAMENT OF PENANCE

The Sacrament of Penance is available every Saturday, except Holy Saturday, from 11:30 am-12:00 nn and from 3:30 - 4:00 pm.

THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

The Common Policy for the Diocese of New Jersey requires a period of preparation for the Sacrament of Marriage, which includes sessions with the parish priest or deacon and participation in either the Pre-Cana Conference or the Engaged Encounter Weekend. Therefore, arrangements with the Parish Office should be made up to one year in advance, and before any social plans are finalized.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Arrangements for pastoral visitation and Holy Communion to the sick and infirmed at home can be made by contacting the Parish Office. Catholic Chaplains are assigned by the Diocese of Metuchen for patients in our area hospitals. Our Parish is responsible for Rolling Hills Nursing Care Facility. Emergency sick calls anytime.

INVITATION TO MORE... SENIOR SAFETY AWARENESS PROGRAM

The Senior Safety Awareness Program will be held on **Tuesday, May 24th from 2:00-3:30PM in Parish Hall.** The event is open to seniors and caregivers seeking information, tips, or resources about senior safety.

Ensuring elderly safety starts with equipping senior citizens and caregivers with the necessary tips, skills, and resources. The Senior Safety Awareness Program will connect senior citizens or caregivers with comprehensive information, because finding the resources to care for yourself and aging loved ones should not be difficult or overwhelming.

The event will feature several industry professionals in varying areas of expertise. Featured presenters include Hunterdon County Sheriff Frederick Brown, the Hunterdon Medical Center Visiting Nurses Association, and the Clinton Township Police Department.

All are welcome to learn about enhancing and supporting senior safety from a variety of professionals. Topics of discussion will include: dependable in-home care assistance, simple but essential senior financial needs (including the importance of having an updated will, power of attorney, medical directive, living wills, and updating beneficiaries of retirement accounts and insurance policies), combating cyber and/or telephone scams, injury and falls proofing, protections against fire and related dangers, home safety assessments, and the Blue Angel program.

There will be a question and answer opportunity with the presenters on each topic. Presenters will also be available at the conclusion of the program to answer further questions and provide more information.
